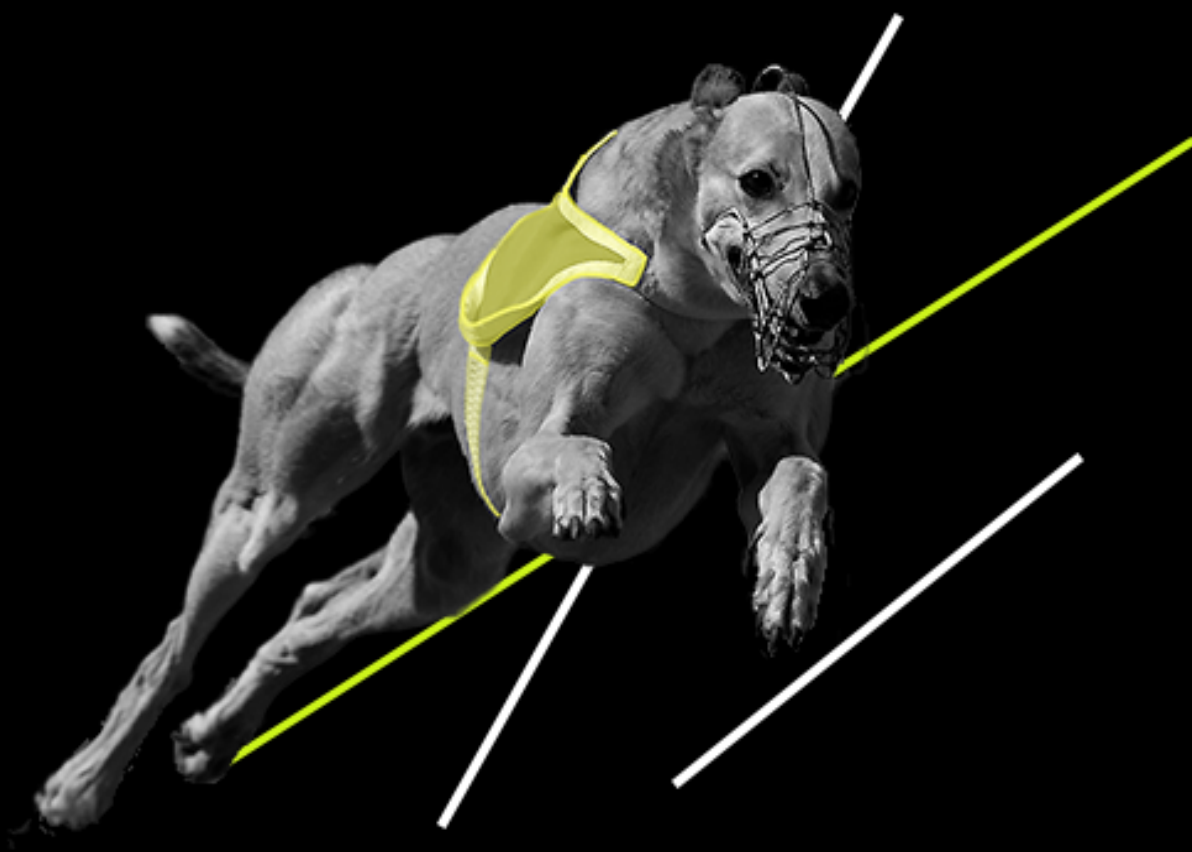

## About UK Greyhound Racing

The Greyhound Board of Great Britain (GBGB) is responsible for regulating the operation of licenced greyhound racing in England, Scotland and Wales. As well as overseeing each race track and the running of each race, they are responsible for regulating the welfare and care of all racing greyhounds from registration to retirement. They are staffed by world-leading experts including vets, academics and animal welfare specialists.

The animal Welfare Act 2006 provides primary legislation covering the housing, transportation and care of greyhounds. These conditions are contained, alongside the rules and procedures for racing in a comprehensive Rules of Racing standard, developed and enforced by the officers of the GBGB.

### Ownership

Tracks are privately owned and elect to run under the governance and rules of the GBGB. Tracks secure the services of professional trainers, licenced by the GBGB to provide greyhounds available for racing. The racing officials employed by each track and also licenced by the GBGB will construct races comprising of those greyhounds and in accordance with the GBGB rules. They aim to construct races of greyhounds of equal ability based on recorded time and race form.

### Funding

Prize money for all finishing positions is paid by tracks to trainers along with any direct commercial payments. The value of prize money in each race is relative to the class or standard of the race – typically a standard distance race might include 10 grades (A1-A10) with A1 comprising of the fastest greyhounds competing for the largest purses. The tracks raise revenue through the media rights sale of the racing to bookmakers and income derived from on-course attendees through food, drink and wagering activities. The GBGB is funded by license fees from race tracks, trainers, the registration of greyhounds and for allowing races to be broadcast through any media.

In addition, UK bookmakers pay a voluntary (0.6% of turnover) contribution from race betting to provide support for the welfare and integrity of the sport and this is paid back into the industry through a representative body – the British Greyhound Racing Fund. (BGRF). An example of this is a c£1.4M annual payment that the BGRF makes to the Greyhound Trust – a dedicated charity for the homing of retired racing greyhounds.

### Gambling Commission

Betting on greyhounds is licenced by the UK's Gambling Commission for both fixed odds and pari-mutuel wagering in accordance with The Gambling Act 2005.

The individual tracks and any individual or company wishing to host wagering on the racing are separately licenced and will operate under the conditions of those licences incorporating all current KYC and AML legislation.

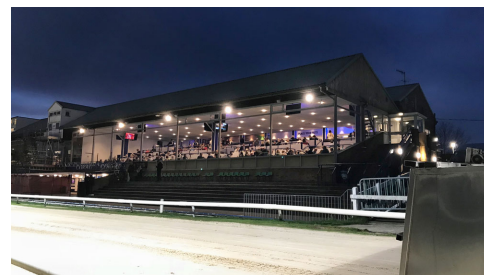

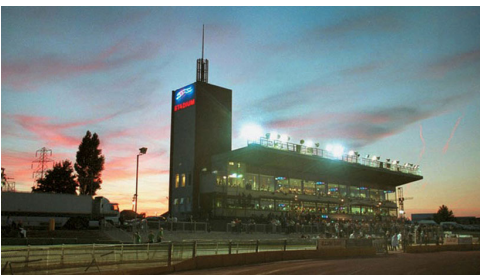
