Race 1 4-6-5

4 MASTERWORK has been going longer while up in class since the claim and his form might be a bit dirtied up; was sent on a fast pace after failing to break sharply from the gate in that last one over a wet track; tried rating one start prior and wound up getting rank, before racing on behind his winning entrymate; lands in a solid field for the level dropping back down but might be a fair price. 6 LUCENCY earned an 82 Beyer breaking his maiden three back then matched that figure when just missing in an entry-level allowance in his next start; taking class relief after failing to land a blow vs. a tough field last time.

Race 2 3 STARSHIP DEFIANT was also no match for Leave No Trace two back when just lasting for third over the top one; was part of a fast pace going seven here 11 days ago before weakening; clearly dangerous cutting back a furlong in this spot. 6 I'M BUZZY won four straight while steadily rising in class and striking while the iron was hot through January and February; had that winning streak snapped last time when catching a speed-favoring track vs. a better field; cuts back. 4 PROUD FOOT was mildly disappointing last time when failing as the favorite, though the winner of that race has ample back class and seemed to finally get back on track in that spot; form since the Dutrow claim has been solid and this field did not come up as tough

Race 3 3-5-1

3 LEADERSHIP ABILITY got loose on the drop when breaking his maiden in an odd-turf race going a mile last summer; chased and gave way vs. tougher in her first start off the claim, then raced wide over a track that was favoring the inside when eased last time; drops again. 5 FRANNIE LEW was only second-best but made heavily-favored Voleuse earn that win at this level three starts back; drops back down in class for this after finishing behind that rival once again last time; looks well-spotted and there might be a good trip coming.

Race 4 3-1 entry-5

3 HIGHER QUALITY was a photo away from winning three straight on this circuit last year then earned an 81 Beyer winning over this distance at Pimlico in September; form has held up since then while mostly facing tougher than this and he gets class relief for his return from a short layoff.

Race 5 5-1-4

5 ECHO IN ETERNITY caught wet tracks in each of her first three starts and never seriously threatened while facing some good fields; won her first start over fast dirt last time when also getting a bit more distance to work with, though her figure declined in that spot; half-sister Ice Princess is a stakes winner and Grade 3-placed routing on dirt. 1 SCORING CHANCE was the lone firster in that field when winning easily going seven last November with a solid 66 Beyer; only other start found her getting outrun early over a wet track that she may not have cared for; bred to get more distance and can rebound if ready off the bench

Race 6 8-6-3

8 TAX IMPLICATIONS- Settled for second in three straight stakes following an easy debut win as a 2yo; seemed to have excuses in a couple of the early losses while her figures were improving in defeat; final two starts last year were a bit disappointing, particularly that Winter Memories here in September where she was rated early and then never made a serious run to contention; has regrouped since then and starts back with Lasix on while landing in the right kind of spot; clearly dangerous. 6 SILVER SKILLET -NY-bred ran some good races on dirt early on but her game picked up with the surface switch last summer; after a good effort in the surface debut she won two in a row vs. fellow state-breds, including a stake at Saratoga; ran well in two open stakes at the end of the year on this surface, though she had no excuse either time and just wasn't quite good enough; scratched from Sunday's Plenty of Grace to await this spot; contender.

Race 7 4-6-5

4 George's Vice -Was laid up off the claim and made her return from the layoff on dirt for Linda Rice; promptly won her first two starts on this surface vs. weaker, and she earned a competitive figure in the second of those victories; was nowhere in her first two starts when moved up to this level; something to prove now but there is no drop in class by a trainer who does not generally enter her horses where they cannot compete.

6 Easy Play Five-time winner broke her maiden over this track over two years ago for a tag; four subsequent wins have all come at Finger Lakes; rarely Beyers out of the 60s but has been consistent and owns some early speed; Franco takes over

Race 8 1-4-6-8

1 Capital Spending -\$45k yearling purchase is by 9% debut sire Central Banker, who wins with 8% of his turf sprint starters; the dam (21:5-3-1, \$216k, 82 Beyer) achieved all of her victories on dirt and was 0-for-7 on turf; her only foal to race is a minor dirt winner; the dam is a half-sister to multiple dirt stakes winner Wudda U Think Now (21:9-4-2, \$564k) and multiple turf winner C d'Cat (11:3-4-2, \$166k); Jorge Abreu is 6-for-36 (17%, \$1.91 ROI) with first time starters in turf sprints over 5 years; missed some training time between February and March, but has worked steadily since.

4 -Turriga Did everything but win on debut when making a late run after a gate-to-wire winner after letting that one run off on the front end early; was unable to build on that performance in her 2nd start, but she was stretching out around two turns and breaking from the far outside post in a 12-horse field; unsurprisingly got a 2 to 4-wide trip, and was never beating her talented stablemate, who won on debut; tried dirt once over the winter, but confirmed she's a turf horse; now finally gets back into an appropriate spot; arguably the horse to beat.

Royal Palm Meet Statistics:

Best Bet: 11-2-2-1 (\$0.87/\$3.65) **Longshot:** 11-2-1-3 (\$1.91/\$5.76)

Race 1: It looks like **2 ADIOS ASHER** will be tough to kick off the week, as not only does he go off-the-claim for Dibona (24%), but he's the best horse in the race and looks the controlling speed as well. From there the duo of **4 CHRISTENSEN** and **7 KITTEN'S SPA** look next up after running 2-3 at the level last time, with the former getting the edge again based on his tactical speed.

SELECTIONS: 2-4-7-3

Race 2: A switch to the turf really woke up **2 TINTA ROJA**, who flew early and held OK when 5th last time, and looks loose on the lead here. They all have to beat **6 PARALLEL** off that troubled 2nd against better, though he's been on the board without winning in all seven starts, which doesn't entice. Not sold on **3 PRIVACY SETTING** just because he's MSW dropping, though this could wake him up. (Tapeta: 2-6-3-5)

SELECTIONS: 2-6-3-5

Race 3: Speed plays sprinting on the Tapeta, and that's what **2 SHEZA RAJUN CAJUN** has in spades, so let's hope she breaks running and forgets to stop. The chalk and horse to beat, **5 NO ACTION**, will be chasing early and should keep the pick in her sights, and that nose 2nd last time would be good enough here. A rise in class off an all-out

N2L win might trip up **1 TRUE MARTINI**, who got no help from this rail draw either.

SELECTIONS: 2-5-1-7

Race 4: A matchup between **6 TOVIA** and **1 GENERAL ROBINSON**—who were 2-3 when facing off 2/15—again goes to the former, as she's got the speed the latter doesn't, which is always going to give her a tactical edge. Not expecting **2 SUBTLE FAITH** to turn the tables after she was 4th to the top-2, so play her underneath, if at all.

SELECTIONS: 6-1-2-5

Race 5: A cutback, return to Tapeta, and MSW drop could all help get **10 DEVIL'S PLAYGROUND** over the hump after some middling finishes, especially against this modest group. They have to run down and beat **4 PARAKEET**, a strong 2nd against better OTC for Dibona, though value lies elsewhere. Don't sleep on **5 RED ABARRIO** for crafty connections, as he's another cutting back and returning to Tapeta.

SELECTIONS: 10-4-5-11

Race 6: It's Best Bet time with **7 CANTARO**, a class-dropping stalker in a race loaded with speed, who seems to get all the best of it today. Drawing outside the other speed

should help the cause of **5 THREE ZERO**, and he's been in good form, though pressing the pace and holding off the pick won't be easy. Mixed signals with **4 NO DELIBERATION**, who was 6-for-6 on Tapeta but was a disappointing 6th last time.

SELECTIONS: 7-5-4-2

Race 7: The lone runner entering off a turf win is **5 FLAT TOP BOX**, and while it was in the MCL ranks, he's OTC for Spatz, who has had a banner year, and doesn't dip in often. Saffie has both **7 MISTER ABARRIO** and **8 SUNSHINE FROLIC**, and both make sense, with the former going OTC and getting back to turf, while the latter was a close 6th against a solid group in his lone grass try two-back. (Tapeta: 5-7-8-3)

SELECTIONS: 5-7-8-3

Race 8: We close out the card with today's Longshot, **7 AVELLINO**, who was 3rd against two solid groups in her two Tapeta starts, and catches a potentially vulnerable favorite. Which leads us to **8 DR. RAY D.**, who is 2-for-2 on Tapeta but has been off since 1/4, so you have to think something went amiss, yet she'll be a short price, and it's not like she had a big margin for error to begin with. No knocks on **6 ROTUNDO**, who looked good winning her Tapeta debut last month at the level and figures right back.

SELECTIONS: 7-8-6-4

Best Bet: R6: #7 Cantaro (5-2)

- * Class dropper has been facing better
- * Stalker should get a hot pace up front
- * Other favorites hurt by the early pace

Longshot: R8: #7 Avellino (8-1)

- * Solid runs in both Tapeta starts
- * Speed to be close throughout
- * Meets potentially dicey favorite

Race 3

BEST BET:6 BIGFOOT CITY returns to the turf and that is for the best. His last six turf figs are all between 72 and 81. This gelding goes third off the layoff and that has to help. We know he likes this sod and loves this distance. Voided claim from two back had no ill effects in his most recent when 4th as the favorite but with a decent 68 Beyer. Win rider returns in Lopez. This horse should find the front end as that is just what he does. This barn is 26% going dirt to turf. 3 MAN FRIDAY ran OK off the layoff and got a nice 80 Beyer. We like that he returns right on time. Connections find a spot where this guy can't be claimed. Lone local try was a bit disconcerting but this horse did bobble at the start. 4 THE RIGHT STUFF is capable on the green something he returns to today. This barn is 20% going dirt to turf. Local works are a nice touch. This horse figures to be forwardly placed and could get first run on our top pick if that one falters.

Race 4 1SMOKEMONTHECLIFF ran well off the break and then not so much in her most recent but did try tougher. Does the added half furlong help or hurt? If the 3, 4, and 5 all show speed then a stalking trip would work nicely. This barn shows a flat bet profit on the dirt, in sprints, and with their claimers. Form cycle hints at better also. 3WOK DON'T RUN goes from an 8% barn to a 20% barn. Team Belvoir is 30% with new runners, 32% off this type of layoff, 21% on the dirt, 19% with their sprinters, and 15% with their claimers. This filly figures a good trip and has four local works. 5WHATWASTHENISNOW just ran a Beyer top. She has speed but so do others. Second time this dirt is a plus. This filly has passed a runner before so maybe, just maybe, that is an option. Figueroa gets a leg up and is 21% for this barn.

Race 5 7 HOLLYWOOD IMPACT broke sharp in his debut before taking back and running evenly. That race experience comes in handy today. This gelding draws tons better and keeps his debut rider in Cruz. Added half furlong will help. 4 DYIN A THIRST is by a 10% debut sire (all sire stats are for 2YOs only). Her dam went 12-4-2-2 for 193K. Of 10 sibs to race, 8 won and 7 beat winners. This filly is a January bred so she has an age advantage over all of these. 5 DANCING PORKY got some play in his debut and then ran evenly after breaking 7th of 9. One of two in here for this barn. Arboleda stays put and is 38% for this barn

Race 6

1 DRIVE TRAIN got some play in his debut at Horseshoe Indy but only beat one home. After working at Keeneland, this colt ends up here. We like how new connections (owner/trainer) find a spot where this colt can't be claimed. Corbett gets a leg up and is 83% for this barn (5 for 6). First Lasix can only help and this 3YO has a local work. 6 KING ZOG ran well in his most recent and now goes second time this dirt. He draws fine and has some tactical speed to help his trip. 4 BAY BOSS is by a 10% debut sire. His dam went 47-14-9-7 and earned 462K. Lone sib is 2-0-1-1 and earned 11K. Works are well spaced and the price will entice.

Race 7

2 PANZER PRIDE will be content to sit early and try to blitz these late. He was squeezed at the start in his most recent and that had to hurt. A return to the dirt is a plus as this barn is 25% going turf to dirt. This gelding gets to save all the early ground with his inside draw. 5 TIGER HUNTER is feeling good and now goes third off the layoff. This barn is a very good 33% with horses that won their last race. This gelding will have to break in a new jockey today but this barn has used Rodriguez before. If looking for a knock then there isn't much pace in this race. 7 HOT MEMORIES ran evenly in his last two sprints so why not take a shot going two turns. Someone in this race will show speed so why not this guy? Second time with Cruz up can only help.

Race 8 3 TROUBLE N PARADISE has speed something there isn't a lot of in this shortened sprint. She puts three races together and won her only race going this distance. Santa Anita invader ends up in a barn that is 30% with new runners. 5 WHERE'S FRANKIE just won a shortened sprint and is now 4 for 9 on this dirt. New barn is 1 for 3 off the claim. This mare has some speed but can stalk just as easily. 4 PRINCESS JAYLEEN won going five furlongs only two back. She was stuck on the rail in her most recent where she broke 7th of 10. Those tries 2, 3, and 4 back are all solid. This filly is often a good price.

Race 9

5 CHESTERETTE is a hard trier that has hit the exacta in 7 of 10 starts. She likes this dirt at 2-1-1-0. She has won off a layoff before and even done so here six back. Her tactical speed comes in handy today as there isn't much pace in this race. She is working at Sunland and that is OK as we think local works can be taxing for any horse shipping in from New Mexico. This barn is 24% with horses that won their last race. 6 MISS UNION has now run well in both local starts. New barn is 57% off the claim. We spy a recent work which can only help and we like that Cruz keeps the call (2 for 4 for this barn). 7 ASENSA is capable of a Beyer in the 80's which she has done twice in her last six starts. She got a nice confidence boost last out. She puts three races together and draws outside for a good trip. Is this mare the speed?

BEST BET - HILLEXOTIC (2nd)

SPOT PLAY - NOWHERE CREEK A (11th)

Race 1 - 25000CLM Pace

(5) MAJOR DESIRE closed with some pace in the final quarter last week in his first try at this level. Tonight he gets an improved post to work with and another chance with Yannick Gingras in the bike. (2) FLOW WITH JOE has an inside draw for the first time since back in early March and showed the ability to finish a rallying third against \$30,000 claimers two back. (1) ARRHYTHMIC SURGE is making his 2024 pari-mutuel debut in this event. He qualified well down at Freehold on 4-19 and was racing in higher classes than this at the end of last year.

Race 2 - Invitational Trot

(3) HILLEXOTIC got the job done in his first try of the year last Thursday and I expect him to only improve with that race under his belt. (6) NOWS THE MOMENT didn't threaten a week ago after he took back and raced from off-the-pace. He's a known commodity in this class and is going to get a new driver with Jordan Stratton taking the call. (2) I GET IT drew well again and owns a win at this level back on 3-28.

Race 3 - (3) B NICKING gets a drop and a slightly better post to work with tonight. He was a gaining fourth in a NW30000L5 event a week ago. (1) BLACK TIE BASH exits the John Brennan Trotting Series and starts from the pole after having the six-hole and seven-hole in his last two tries. The last time he drew inside on 3-22, he was victorious. (4) JULA MUSCLE PACK is riding a two-race win streak. Those did come at lower levels, but he also shows hitting the board against NW30000L5 rivals back in mid-February.

Race 4 - F&M Invitational Trot

(2) TIPSY MONI miscued before the start last week and disappointed as the favorite. That break was out of character for her, so I will look for her to bounce right back, especially since she gets to start from the inside and normally when she races in this class she has a poor post. (1) PERFECT VIXEN has hit the board in six of her last seven outings, including a third, a win and a second in three efforts at this level. (4) P L NOTSONICE took advantage of TIPSY MONI's mistake and put in a solid effort to win the F&M Invitational Trot a week ago. I'll include underneath tonight.

Race 5 - 3-5YO 30000CLM Pace

(2) BIG DREAM FELLA finished out his mile well in his last appearance on 4-4 and had a two-race win streak in this class in March. (1) FINAL CHEESERECIPE rallied and came up just half a length short of the winner in his first effort at this level last Thursday. He continues to draw well, too, and I'll include. (3) URIEL BLUE CHIP was third in the same tilt that FINAL CHEESERECIPE exits and gets post relief off that performance.

Race 6 - NAADA Amateur Spring Series Leg #7 Trot

(4) BACARDI tallied two back at Freehold, and although he wasn't a factor in the amateur tilt at Yonkers last Thursday, I'm going to bank on him getting a more aggressive drive tonight with a switch to Tony Beltrami. (3) ALLINDOTIME didn't threaten in an amateur race last week but gets significant post relief here and has won three times in his last seven trips behind the gate. (2) WINNERESS is another horse getting to slide in on the gate after a pair of outside draws both here at Yonkers and over at Monticello.

Race 7 - (6) STEUBEN HANOVER moves out on the gate a bit here but closed with plenty of trot last week in his first try for trainer Alexander and has had plenty of success in this class through 2024. (4) INN AT RODANTHE was the winner in the same race my top selection comes out of. He hadn't tallied yet this year before that, so he should have renewed confidence. (1) HOMER HALL comes in from Pocono with a couple of on-the-board efforts in three starts and an inside post

Race 8 - NAADA Amateur Spring Series Leg #7 Trot

(4) SHOEMAKER HANOVER dominated on the front-end at Freehold last Saturday (April 20), making him two-for-two in the win column this year when he hasn't been saddled with an outside draw. (1) RACEACE is riding a five-race streak of top-three finishes and drew the pole position tonight after having back-to-back seven-holes at Monticello. (3) ALL RISE also romped on the lead at Freehold in a separate amateur division on 4-20. He should be sharper here as that was his first pari-mutuel try of 2024.

Race 9 - (5) ALL CHAMPY makes his third start back after the layoff tonight, and I'm going to bank on him being ready to fire. He had an excellent campaign last year that included several wins at much higher levels than this. (1) THE BALLYKEEL DEAL gets some post relief in her second attempt in this class and was a winner at Yonkers in late March. (8) BLUEBIRD BISHOP drew the eight-hole but is exiting the John Brennan Trotting Series and is a second-time starter out of Per Engblom's barn.

Race 10 - (2) NOWHERE CREEK A exits back-to-back post eight starts here, and he also had bad draws twice in March. The one he had a good post on 4-1, he was a closing third in this class. (3) KERFORD ROAD A is the current ruler of this level as he has three straight victories and drew inside again tonight. (5) PAT STANLEY N has a pair of tallies of his own against \$30,000 claimers, sandwiched around a third-place result on April 4.
