## NY Hot List races to watch – Friday, April 19, 2024 at Aqueduct By Matt Shifman and Bob Ehalt

**3<sup>rd</sup> race** [OC50k/SAL50k, 6F] – (3) **Dylan's Ruby** was a debut winner at Parx in a \$50,000 maiden claimer at 5-2 and then ran second in an allowance three weeks ago. (2) **Mad Banker** broke his maiden against NY-breds and then has been competitive in tough company since then. This seems to be a softer spot. (1) **Stormquist** and (1A) **Remember the Name** make a Linda Rice entry where both are win contenders. (6) **Heard On Thestreet** won a \$20,000 maiden claimer by eight lengths three weeks ago.

5<sup>th</sup> race [Md 40000, 6 ½ F] – (5) <u>Don Vino Vici</u> (B) got bumped and fouled resulting in getting moved up to second by disqualification and was claimed for \$40,000. (1) <u>Play</u> will make the move from maiden special weight to claimer which is a move in which Linda Rice has gaudy statistics winning at 53% of her last 15 starters. (7) <u>Polish Up</u> made his debut back in August at 9-1 and finished third for a barn that does very well following long layoffs. (6) <u>Betta Go Go Go</u> has hit the board in 5 out of his first 6 starts in Florida and changes barns with the move to New York.

**6<sup>th</sup> race** [Clm 25000 N2L, 1 mi] – (5) <u>Principe d'Oro</u> will drop into a N2L claimer for the first time for Rice with good performances against much better last year. (1) <u>Ice Road</u> was third and then second in his last two races for the N2L condition. (3) <u>Beary Funny</u> got claimed from his last starts which were a maiden claiming win and a third in the N2L level. (2) <u>Petrolo</u> made one start this year last month and set the pace for a \$40,000 tag.

8<sup>th</sup> race [NY, Md 30000, 1 mi] – (9) <u>Irie Man</u> (A) had a bad break where he ducked in and ended up last. He moved up and got into contention but stalled out in fourth. (8) <u>Janssen</u> pressed the pace and finished second in his last two starts in maiden claimers. (4) <u>I'm Just</u> has been off since August when he was a voided claim for \$40,000. He comes back as a new gelding with the blinkers off. (3) <u>Watch</u> <u>Hill</u> was second at this level last month when he broke a step slowly and then rallied.

Best bets: Dylan's Ruby (3<sup>rd</sup>); Principe d'Oro (6<sup>th</sup>). Best value: Don Vino Vici (5<sup>th</sup>); Irie Man (8<sup>th</sup>).
