7th: 2-1-5-7 By leading sire Into Mischief, one will struggle to find a stronger pedigree than **#2 Roswell**. Her dam, Acoma, who was a seven-time GSW between 2008 & 2010, with the highlight of her career coming in the 2010 Grade 1 Spinster Stakes at Keeneland. One of the most impressive aspects of Acoma's career was the fact that she won two Grade 3 races on dirt, four Graded Stakes on turf, and the aforementioned Spinster Stakes success came on the synthetic.

Acoma herself was a half sister to Grade 1 winner, Arch, and their grand dam (Roswell's great grand dam) was Althea, a seven-time GSW, who won the Grade 1 Startlet Stakes and the Grade 1 Santa Susana Stakes before she defeated the boys in the 1984 Arkansas Derby. (You guessed it – she was trained by 'The Coach' D. Wayne Lukas!) One thing that stands out regarding Roswell's pedigree, (other than the fact that it's full of Grade 1 winners), is how much stamina there is. Therefore, I thought that it was impressive how she has been able to show so much speed in both her career starts. She beat four future winners when breaking her maiden on debut and finished a strong closing 2nd to next out stake winner, Launch, in her second start. Roswell looks set to thrive over today's 7 1/2f distance. She remains unexposed, has some of the strongest form on offer, will likely be on or near the lead and has been freshened up since her last start. To me, she looks one of the likeliest winners on the card and if the 5/2 morning line holds, those odds could be made to look a gift.

8th: 5-7-3-2. Isaac Murphy Marathon

Don't get me wrong, I love #7 Next as much as the next guy, but I am really keen to take him on in the Isaac Murphy Marathon Overnight Stakes, which goes as race eight on the card. The reason behind my thinking simply comes down to his record off layoffs. In his 2021 debut, he finished 11th in the American Turf Stakes, in his 2022 debut he finished 4th in an allowance at Turfway and last year he finished 3rd as the 6/5 favorite in this race, which was a weaker renewal than we have on Wednesday. Instead, I am loving the 5/1 morning line odds on **#5 Classic Causeway**, who will be making his second start of the year for Kenny McPeck. What he has gone onto achieve has to be commended, with the highlight of his career coming by way of his gate to wire win in the 2022 Belmont Derby (G1). Following a 230-day layoff, his 2nd place finish in the 1 1/2-mile Temperance Hill Stakes at Oaklawn was a massive effort, leading right up to the final few strides before getting nailed by #6 Masqueparade, who re-opposes today. Running well off a layoff going 5f is one thing but going that close over 1 ½ miles is another. He finished well in front of #3 Red Run, #4 O P Firecracker and #8 Master Game, who all return today and it's important to note that all four of these re-opposing rivals had a race fitness advantage over Classic Causeway last time. So, when you consider that he's the only Grade 1 winner in the line-up, beat three of today's rivals last time, will have stepped forward from that run and the favorite looks very vulnerable, the 5/1 morning line odds could make him the bet of the day.

9th: William Walker Stakes...# **1 Mansa Musa** showed a new dimension in first American start last time at Keeneland. In that race, his first since September, he was off slowly, but rallied from 11th to finish second beaten by just a neck. That was a change in running style after being a front running type last year in Ireland, and could suit him well in this \$ 300 k stakes with plenty of early speed types.

## TAMPA BAY DOWNS ( 12:25)

1<sup>ST</sup> 7 STYLISH ANNA is tough to trust as she makes her first start around two turns but trainer Juan Arriagada does well (22% win rate) with horses stretching out from sprints to routes and this is a field full of runners with flaws; worth a shot as possibly the main speed in this field. 5 LUCKY IN LOVE is certainly a logical threat after hitting the board in each of her last three starts; obviously dangerous in the lane, though she could be overbet some given her Beyer edge, as she's had 13 tries. 8 TOUGH DAME is the first starter out of an unraced dam but perhaps routing on the main track will be her game; upgrade candidate off her latest, when off the lead early on in a paceless turf race.

Race 2 2 BUCCHANERA came back a new horse after the layoff, and with Lasix, powering to an easy win after outsprinting several other speeds to make the lead; that was a big race under the circumstances and she's candidate to repeat with a similar effort. 3 ROCK ME AMADEUS was well bet for her debut and she overcame a slow start to win it with a good late run; main threat in the lane once again. 7 AMERICAN PEACHES has the speed to stay close, and that should mean she's well spotted from the start; aided by a forward trip in a sprint lacking pace last time but the Beyer has to be respected.

Race 3 7 JUSTINTIMEFORWINE comes off a gate-to-wire score in his first start off the layoff, against allowance runners, and he looms the controlling speed once again today, and he's meeting lesser; can win another if he's able to get clear easily enough, as he did in that last one. 6 VENEZUELAN TRIUMPH is the main rival to the top pick, based on his best back turf figures; easily forgiven for his last two, on dirt and synthetic, as he may well be at his best on the green. 4 HARPOON HARRY didn't run to his best figures in his latest but he's another with back Beyers that give him strong credibility; tactical speed a plus.

Race 4 7 KIKILOVE exits consecutive races which featured a good amount of speed and thus set up very well for the closers (note bold "C" symbols in DRF pp's); this sprint is light on pace, and that could mean she's on the lead this time around, and a clear lead would make her tough to reel in. 5 DRILL'S VALENTINE is an upgrade candidate after racing off the pace in sprints with speed-friendly race flows, and though she's in a similar predicament here she may be able to threaten if she can stay close in the opening stages. 6 MELANCHOLY BLUES adds blinkers and that could sharpen her speed, giving her an edge on the stone closers if the fractions are in fact controlled.

Race 5 6 PHOBIA makes his Tampa debut and he may find the locals more his speed, after failing to break his maiden in four starts at Gulfstream; this is not a deep field and though he's had his chances few have been in spots as soft as this. 7 MILCHIN was off the board in his turf debut but that was no easy trip, as he was caught up in a race-long duel from the start and he tired only late; could be better here with that experience under his belt.

1 THEREGOESMYMIRACLE nearly broke his maiden in his 31st start, missing by just a neck, and the resulting Beyer gives him credibility, even if that figure was enhanced by a very favorable trip and set up.

Race 6 2 MR. BONES comes out of a speed-filled sprint and now stretches out and gets an inside post, which should translate to a forward trip; trainer Kevin Rice does well with horses stretching out and he could prove tough to catch if he can get away with an unpressured lead. 6 GUN RIGHT benefited from a favorable pace scenario when he closed in that last one but that was a decent try nonetheless, and the Beyer he posted in the maiden win two back puts him in the middle of this; should be running late. 5 MALIBU MIKE has been in search of that elusive second career win for some time but he does have steady figures and a decent late kick.

Race 7 4 CLASSICSTATEOFMIND gave way on the turn in that return from the layoff but that certainly can be dismissed, as it likely merely served as a prep in his first start off the layoff, and on the dirt; back on grass here and he's a proven turf sprinter, and he can be expected to turn things around quickly, especially given a loose lead. 1 WORA is another returning to his preferred surface, and his best turf/sprint Beyers make him a contender with these, if he can run to them; gets the hedge and will need to work out a trip as he tries to find clear sailing late. 3 THEALLIGATORHUNTER wasn't badly beaten when last seen, in the Turf Dash, and that was clearly against better; the concern is the layoff, which comes on the heel of another break, though he certainly would be no surprise.

Race 8 3 CAPTURE THE TIME is in very good form for trainer Reynaldo Yanez, hitting the board in each of his last five starts, and a big part of his success is his tactical speed; that asset should serve him well in this sprint, which is a little light on early zip, and given a forward trip he should be able to run to his best figures. 7 WELL CONNECTED was 1st or 2nd in each of his last nine starts prior to the layoff, and he's clearly a threat here if he's ready off the bench; has speed but he can also rate and make one run if need be. 2 BUFF HELLO was behind several of these same runners two back but that was due to an unfavorable race flow, and he proved that by coming out of that race to run a strong 2nd in his latest; another with the versatility to race on the lead or come from off the pace.

Race 9 BEST BET 12 ARIANA VALENTINA will be wide here but she's otherwise very well spotted as a closer in a race that's filled with early pace, and she should be well set up; can run them all down late given a clean trip and a fast, contested pace to chase. 11 CLASSIC DREAMER is another who stands to benefit from the expected race flow, as she should be ideally spotted behind a duel involving any number of runners. 6 SARATOGA GAZE has the speed to stay close but she has shown that she's capable of sitting off the speeds and making a late impact, as she did in her most recent win back in December; dangerous here with that type of trip.

- 8** MARVELOUSMOONDANCE – Sufficient ability and gets edge despite not finishing in front in 44 starts.
- 4** TITANIUM RECKAGE – Led for half mile in longer test before faltering last week; progress likely.

- 6** GAMERUN – Difficult to support off latest and numerous losses with strong backing recent months.

Race 4

3 EZ ALL THE WAY ran evenly in her first three starts and that should help with today's stretch-out. In a four horse field, everyone gets a good trip. This filly goes for a barn that is 24% going sprint to route and that could prove the tipping point. 1 SWEET AND EZ has speed and the rail as she tries two turns for the first time. This barn is 12% going sprint to route. An early breather would go a long way but we spy two others who could show speed so a good break is key. 2 LA DELHOMME'S SHOW is often right there but just can't finish some good tries. This is her first going two turns so maybe that helps shake things up.

Race 5

6 HERON BAY is royally bred for the grass yet can't win on the grass even with a Hall of Fame trainer in Neil Drysdale, right? Some horses just develop later than others and maybe this filly is a good example. She goes second time this sod and puts races together and that alone might be enough. Beaten favorite angle applies if you like that. This race didn't come up very tough for the level. Christmas comes early if this filly wins at anything near 4-1 morning line. 5 MARK OF VICTORY loves, loves, loves to finish 2nd as she has done just that in over half of her starts. Form cycle hints at better but this barn is only 9% on the green. 1 CY'S SILKSTOCKING showed speed in her most recent and now draws the rail so a front running trip is more likely than not.

Race 6

3 KEEN HEIR is a proven router that just ran a Beyer top of 85. He is only a 5YO so we like his chances of continued improvement. Race flow is fine and this guy draws the same. This horse obviously loves this dirt where he has never missed the board while hitting the exacta in three of four. 5 TONY'S TAPIT is just a solid runner that returns to two turns. He is 5-2-1-0 going this mile distance. This Silva Jr barn is a very nice 35% going sprint to route. This horse turns around quickly but that is OK as connections just wanted a final race before closing day on Saturday. 4 DESHAMBEAU exits the same race as our top pick and wasn't that far behind

## Race 7

7 MISSCZECH is the value as she sits at 8-1 on the morning line. We bet she needed her return try two back and that five furlongs was simply too short in her most recent. Form cycle hints at better as she puts three races together. Did you see that recent bullet work? This mare is capable of a Beyer in the high 60's to low 70's which certainly fits here and we even like this outside post. 2 PRESENT TIME has speed yet can run well without an early breather. She drops in class and should hold the rail for a good chunk of this race. 3 OCTANE is a hard trier no matter the distance but tries a real, dirt, surface for the first time today. Works are quite good and her price should entice.

## Race 8

BEST BET 9 HIGH GUNNER exits a key race where 2 of 5 return to win with figs of 76 and 71. We thought her recent turf effort was actually better than it looks as she isn't bred to like the green. She returns to a dirt sprint today and catches a race full of speed. She should trip out best all from this outside post. 1 EMILY SMILES can pass runners and goes third off the layoff. She likes this dirt well enough yet loves this distance at 11-4-2-1. 6 PACIFIC ZIP won when last seen returning off a layoff and that was only four starts back. This barn is 19% with new runners but don't use Morales all that often. Works are solid and we are curious as to the price.

## Race 9

6 MARY MARGARET exits the key common race where 3 of 7 returned to win with figs of 66, 53, and 57. This mare is better of late and adds a half furlong today. Corbett gets a leg up and is 38% for this barn locally. A better break would help. 7 PALACE STAR is just better in her last two starts. Can she put three good races together though? There is a reason why horses are at this level to begin with. We do like her versatile style and she has done all of her winning on this dirt. 10 MISS JOANNIE has some speed and in a race with little zip. She goes second out for new barn and her most recent wasn't that bad all while the favorite. Quick turnaround makes sense as the meet ends in a few days.

## Race 10

3 MEET JOE has yet to hit the board on the grass which is shocking due to superior turf and distance breeding. When last seen on this sod, he did get a Beyer of 65 which fits here. Those efforts two and three back were encouraging while his most recent had him breaking 9th of 11. Lopez gets a leg up and is 26% for this barn locally. 4 JOKER MATT has won twice on this sod, draws fine, has speed, and was right there at the 1/8th pole on this sod only two back. 8 PLAYOFF BOUND is a 9YO that keeps cashing checks. He is an 8 time winner on this sod. Sure, Father Time is catching up to him but he is still capable of a Beyer in the 60's and that is exotics territory at this level.

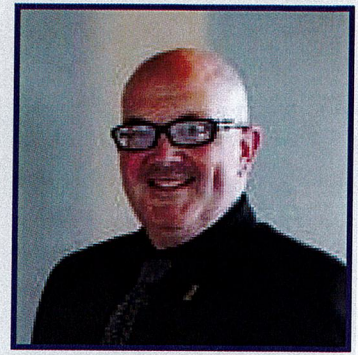

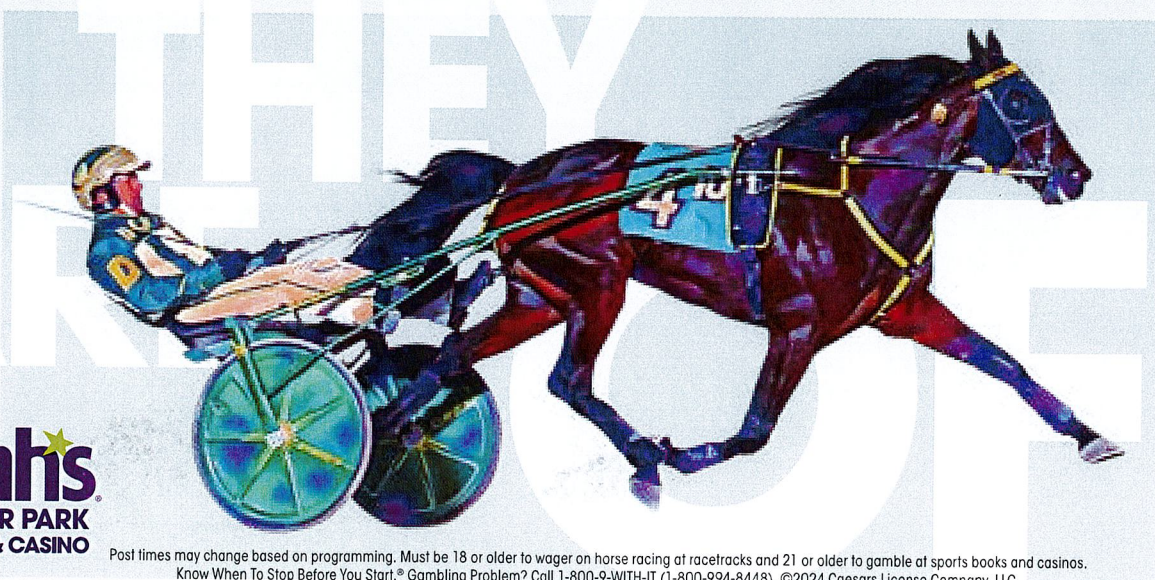
