Championship Meet Statistics (through 12/15):

GP Meet: 120-32-18-23 (\$1.80 /\$5.23) **Best Bet:** 12-4-1-2 (\$1.67/\$4.90) **Longshot:** 8-2-1-1 (\$3.63 /\$9.00)

Race 1: A wide-open opener goes to 8 TAKE ME TO PARIS on the MSW drop, as she's been facing tons better, and the blinkers can sharpen her up early too. Both 9 TIMBER and 6 ALTAMIRA STAR figure for ace connections, as the former is off-the-claim for Crichton (20%) and has Irad, while the latter is another MSW dropper who will like routing for D'Angelo and Saez.

SELECTIONS: 8-9-6-11

Race 2: Taking the short price and moving on with 2 SONADORA GIRL, who looks spotted to score in her local return, especially since she meets an extremely weak field. The main (only?) danger seems 7 PASAJERA, though she's a real guess as she's never tried dirt, and has been routing too. The gap to the rest—including 1 PHAROAHS BABY GIRL—seems a big one.

SELECTIONS: 2-7-1-5

Race 3: The blinkers didn't work with 5 MR TYSON, but they're off today, which resulted in a close 2nd two-back, he has Irad, and gets to run against Fla breds now too. Don't sleep on 4 P FOUR, as he caught a strong open MSW field on the dirt in his debut, which means this is a big drop. Toss the turf route last time and 3 AWESOME EDITION offers value off the close 3rd

against open maidens on Tapeta two-back, and he's a first-time gelding today too.

SELECTIONS: 5-4-3-7

Race 4: The battle between 2 REASSESS and 3 ONE OF ONE goes to the former based on his tactical speed and the class drop, especially since the latter doesn't have much early foot and will be overbet OTC for D'Angelo and Irad, despite a real dud last time. The layoff isn't ideal, but 4 VAYESTA was sharp when he won on Tapeta in September, and he's worked well for this.

SELECTIONS: 2-3-4-7

Race 5: It's tough to get past the trio of favorites here, with the actual winning call going to 10 BURNIN TURF on the drop and freshening, as he looks primed in his return, and has the speed to negate this wide draw too. Blinkers should have 8 SAMBURU a bit closer early, and hopefully more focused late, so he's a must-use off a decent local run against better last time. Not sure what to make of 9 ROTTERDAM off the March layoff, as he could need this, but he's been gelded since, so he could also fire big.

SELECTIONS: 10-8-9-7

Race 6: The winning return of 2 SECRET CHAT could have him poised for another

move forward here, even though he does face open runners, and the way he leveled off late at 7Fs says 1m will be perfect. It's some much-needed class relief for 4 POSITIVE REVIEW, as he's tackled tougher in his last two with middling results, and he'll like getting back to 1m as well. Local lover 1 LURE HIM IN is 5-for-11 here on the dirt, and will trip out, at a decent price too.

SELECTIONS: 2-4-1-3

Race 7: It's Best Bet time with 7 JOKES UP OTC for Fawkes, who puts him back on Tapeta, where she's 2-for-2 here, and Ird named says it's go-time as well. Returning to Tapeta helps 3 BODACIOUS BREN, so she seems the one to fear, while 2 GAYLES EVENING'S good race/bad race pattern says she may bounce back today.

SELECTIONS: 7-3-2-1

Race 8: There are tons of questions on several here, but not 8 PASCHAL MOON, who is 2-for-2 since moving to Dibona, and drew perfectly for this. If 4 PROVERB fires his best they can't beat him, but he's been dreadful in his past two and is now in for a tag, so tread lightly. Getting back to the dirt is big for 1 URANIUM, as is luring Irad, though he also may be off-form for a new barn that has struggled this year.

SELECTIONS: 8-4-1-6

Race 9: Today's Longshot is 7 WINOOSKI, who has turned into a new horse on Tapeta, just aired 13 days ago, and is now right back in a spot where he can't be claimed, which is a confident move. The duo of 2 DEAR DAD and 8 JUNCTION ROAD will be tough after running 3rd and 2nd, respectively on 11/22, but the former can turn the tables,

since that was his first start since May, and he wooed Irad away from the latter as well.

SELECTIONS: 7-2-8-3

Race 10: Sticking with 3 RANDOM HARVEST in a super finale, as she was the pick before scratching in last week's Tropical Park Oaks against 3yofs, and though she meets older here, her upside and talent can get it done. They all have to beat 9 ROOT CAUSE off the stakes 3rd for Brown, though her form is inconsistent, and she'll be a short price too. Tab the tote on 8 PRINCESS BETTINA in her first start for Lynch off what is an eightmonth layoff too, as the barn has been hammered at the windows at the meet, and they have been running to the money.

SELECTIONS: 3-9-8-6

STRONG "TROTTIN' ... FRIDAY" CARD ALSO HAS FEATURES FOR DISTAFF PACERS

All of the high classes for diamondgaited horses are on the card at Harrah's Philadelphia on this Friday program of racing, with a \$15,000 handicap fast-class feature in race seven featuring the likes of ASTEROID, BENJAMIN HANOVER, and PLATINUM AS. The eleventh race \$14,000 co-feature has been widened to allow for "nw 10 races," with GOLDEN RAIN S and SAPPHIRERAINSTAR sure to attract attention (just hope it isn't because of "RAIN"). Distaff pacers, most of them hoping to rise on the classladder, contest \$13,500 in race five, while the \$13,000 tenth race is a handicap event for the fast-class types. ... CHECK OUR SCHEDULE AT BOTTOM!

ANALYSIS OF KEY RACES

1st race: CAPTAIN MARVEL raced in stakes races at two, and impressed his management enough to wait for him a whole year before coming back to the races. If he is somewhat near his top form, he may be ready to win at first asking for Jeff Dauplaise.

9th race: ST LADS BEAT IT shows the same Ottawa-Toronto-Philly shipping pattern and much of the backing of WARRAWEE XALT, who was ultra-impressive winning in the cold last Sunday here. He looks to be in with lesser opposition than he is used to, and may well be the horse to beat today.

12th race: SHORE OF HIMSELF had three very good races at Freehold, then exhibited two different kinds of bad luck in his last two trips behind the gate. Post eight is usually not a way to improve your luck, but having good early speed when the opposition lacks it often improves one's chances; our call despite post.

13th race: INTERNATIONALCRAZE moved early to the lead a level below, then went on to win easily. Speedwise he looks quite competitive, and then there's this: if he wins for driver Todd Schadel, it will be career win #2000 for the recent King of the Pennsylvania Fairs. That would be a good way to end a good year, wouldn't it?

WATCH OUT FOR:

Jim Pantaleano has come to town with the closing of Pocono, and he has been doing well, with four winners last Sunday. He can get the job done any way needed, but he prefers racing on or near the lead if the horse has the early foot. He is definitely a driver to watch as the season winds down.

BEST BET: Lil Sebastian (8th race)

First Race Last Second Louie 2 Not So Holy 5. Whiskey Row

First post is 12:25 ET with 12% takeout on Pick 5 wagers. LAST SECOND LOUIE (1,121 lbs. on 11/29; +25 from prior start; updated weights posted on the simulcast feed during paddock and warmups) tracked the longshot gate-to-wire winner, was placed on a hard chase on the second turn, then kept trying to hold second. He's on a long losing streak, but think he can work out a similar trip from close to the pace. Usually don't trust horses coming from Mountaineer, especially following bad losses at 1-10.

Second Race 4. Joyful Kitten 2 Lottie Deno 7. Princess Lucia

JOYFUL KITTEN (1,083 lbs. on 12/6; +17 from prior start) bobbled slightly at the start two weeks ago, saved ground near the back, split horses with a three-wide bid, then finished evenly with a decent gallop-out behind a runaway. Scored over this course and distance two back and should get pace to attack. LOTTIE DENO (1,186 lbs. on 11/17; +11 from prior start) set a reasonable pace over a closer-friendly track, dispatched the 10-1 pace pursuer (finished last), then stayed for the place. Might have to deal with a quicker early flow this time. PRINCESS LUCIA settled off a fast pace in a race that went to closers (top three finishers were sixth, eighth, and seventh after the opening quarter), swung wide into the stretch, then showed some late ability in her dirt debut. Expecting a similar setup and kick.

Third Race **2.** Golden Philly **3.** Ade **5.** First Pearl

GOLDEN PHILLY battled inside the 2-1 fifth-place finisher, drew clear from that foe just outside the quarter pole, and drew away to score under a drive at Parx. She'll receive a strong class and pace test this afternoon as she faces winners for the first time. ADE was a decisive maiden winner over this course two back, then was in too steep when wired by favored Caprice in the Maryland Juvenile Filly Stakes. Expect her to get much closer to the pace for barn that sent out 8-5 winner Stately Order at Pn Ntl .

Fourth Race 4. True Faith 5. Bustino Santino 3. Bermuda Run

TRUE FAITH, listed as a Parx vet scratch on 9/23, returns from a 118-day layoff after working out a nice trip to graduate at Monmouth. Set a pressured but leisurely pace inside the fifth-finisher over the speed-friendly track, came off the rail turning for home, then stayed strong despite drifting out under left-handed urging. Expensive yearling didn't pan out, but could revitalize his career in these lower-level races.

Fifth Race **6** Lady Serenity **2**. Bad Temper **4**. Gold Time Vixen

LADY SERENITY (1,017 lbs. on 11/15; -4 from prior start) drops in class after facing two next-out winners. Broke well, prompted the pace between rivals, then tired in the stretch. The sixth-finisher then scored for the \$12,000 starter option with a 71 Beyer. Expect good early speed at this reduced class level. BAD TEMPER (1,130 lbs. on 12/7) dips into this conditioned claimer after being wired against open sellers. Pressed a three-ply pace from in between, was outrun into the pocket after a half-mile, cut the corner into the lane, and finished evenly. Expect her to sit back in the early going this time around. GOLD TIME VIXEN took a surprising step forward when necked out at 72-1 odds going two turns at Charles Town. The fourth-finisher then placed in a nickel "beaten" there with a 48 Beyer. It's been a while, but she is a proven commodity over this course and distance and should offer a square price once again.

Sixth Race 12 Silverbullettwenty 6. Shape Note 8 Minister for Magic

SILVERBULLETTWENTY broke a beat slow, raced outside in midpack, made a four-wide bid, floated very wide into the stretch, then kept on grinding to prevail in game fashion over a muddy strip. Perhaps last time was the time at 8-1 odds as he had traffic issues two back, but he seems well-entered against this group, and can contend given the right trip and race flow. SHAPE NOTE pushed a quick pace (22.45; 22.91) before tiring a bit. He's a tactical sport that

Seventh Race 2. Bright Charger 6 Midnight Koa 4 World On Fire

BRIGHT CHARGER (1,096 lbs. on 12/1; +13 from prior start) broke well despite being bumped slightly over closer-friendly track, tracked from two wide/three-path, attacked the 7-2 runner-up from the outside on the turn, the was only one-paced while three deep in the stretch. He may attempt to make the early running this time around for barn that went 18 for 51 (35%, \$2.58 ROI) between 12/3 and 12/14.

Eighth Race **1**. Lil Sebastian **5**. All the Hardways 3. Lightning Boss

LIL SEBASTIAN (1,042 lbs. on 11/28) never received a breather when attempting to stretch his speed around two turns. Set a three-ply pace from in between horses through hot fractions of 23.14 and 23.67, found the inside entering the second turn, then understandably faltered in the stretch. Drop in class and distance should suit, and he might not have to work as hard to find a forward position here. ALL THE HARDWAYS (1,126 lbs. on 11/28; +10 from prior start) appears dirtied-up leading to this assignment. After finishing a good second in the Dover Stakes at Delaware, he found himself in tough in two subsequent stakes races. He might not have been his best on grass two back, then raced wide over sloppy going last time out. LIGHTNING BOSS (1,195 lbs. on 11/30) showed determination and stamina when fending off a prolonged challenge to score at first asking over course and distance. Won't be surprised if he shows good early zip once again.

Ninth Race **1**. A Lotta Moxie **6**. Lachicafortequila **2** Cundi

Two turns might be just what the doctor ordered for A LOTTA MOXIE (1,152 lbs. on 11/17; +2 from prior start), a sizable daughter of Breeders' Cup Classic winner Mucho Macho Man that galloped out nicely after her sprint races two and three starts back. Finished ahead of three of these last time out when wired by a runaway favorite, and the third-finisher from that heat then graduated for \$15,000 with a 51 Beyer. Think she can get closer to the pace for a barn that went 6 for the last 29 (21%, \$4.98 ROI) moving sprint to dirt route. LACHICAFORTEQUILA (996 lbs. on 12/7; -5 from prior start) raced three wide at the rear when cutting back to a sprint, floated very wide turning into the stretch, then got up for the show spot in the final stride despite hopping back to her left lead. Finished ahead of a couple of these and is by a sire with a good amount of stamina. CUNDI (1,047 lbs. on 11/17; +11 from prior start) is often grumpy behind the starting gate and seems hard to trust after 20 previous tries. She stretches out in her third start of the form cycle and might show improved early zip. LYSTRA (1,051 lbs. on 12/7; +45 from prior start) never got out of first gear earlier in the month, but drops precipitously in class after being wired by runaway Mor Mor Mor.

BEST BETS: #4 GORGEOUS VIEW (8th Race)

SPOT PLAY: #7 GRAFENBERG (6th Race)

Race 1: (1) STAND FOR FREEDOM makes her second start off an almost eight month hiatus. In her qualifier on 12/6, she lost by 12 1/4 lengths but in a time that is probably good enough to win this and then came back in her first PM start with a well bet second place finish last week from the rail. 1-2-3

Race 2: (2) MAKE AMERICA GREAT made an explosive three wide move last week from post eight and cleared the lead around the third turn by going 57 1/5 in the middle half and was still fighting at the wire when he got beaten by a head and finished second. He goes third time for Justin Sodano, moves inside off of three poor draws and seems to be well set to find the winner's circle despite being winless in 29 starts in 2024. 2-7-3


Race 5: 3-1-7-5

Race 6: (7) GRAFENBERG has won four of his last seven starts and won at this level on 10/4 in 1:58 1/5. He has overcome outside draws at Freehold this year on a couple of occasions and has good early speed to try and wire this field, which is void of early speed. He picks up Tyler Miller, who might be the perfect complement to his style. 7-3-4

Race 7: (4) ALMOST KAREN won her last two at this level on 12/6 and 11/29 and beat Western Rosie convincingly two back while drawing outside of her. She drops back down and now has tactical position and has enough early speed to land in the pocket to try and combat the favorite again. 4-5-8

Race 8: (4) GORGEOUS VIEW won two of his last six and has cashed checks in five of those six starts. On 10/26, he crushed a field at this level by 7 3/4 lengths in 1:56 with Austin Siegelman in the bike, who is reunited with him here. He has the highest TrackMaster rating in this field and comes in as a beaten favorite. 4-2-5

Race 9: (3) T H MRS MCMURRY has really stepped up her game recently for John Urbanski. She won at this level on 11/8 and then again with new front end tactics on 12/6 at a lower level. Expect her to fire towards the lead in a field void of early speed. (6) JUST MY MAMA disappointed last week at 1:5 odds at this level after shipping back in from the Meadowlands where she was facing tougher. She has hit the board in seven out of her eleven races at Freehold including an easy win against tougher on 9/26 at 1:5 odds. 3-6-4

BEST BET: Political Riot (7th race)

First Race 2. Caller 4 Stop the Press 3. Factor Analysis

CALLER makes his third start of the form cycle for trainer Eoin Harty after an off the pace fourth over this course last out. Harty has been on a roll the last 30 days winning with 4 of 12 starters for an ROI of \$3.31. This includes a pair of Kentucky Derby points races this fall. The Calumet Farm homebred did not have the cleanest voyage in his initial try over the Tampa lawn, but should move forward here as Jesus Castanon jumps aboard. STOP THE PRESS has had a plethora of chances since his debut run at Churchill Downs back in November of 2023. The \$1.5M FTS August purchase has been given time by Shug McGaughey after racing at Aqueduct this fall and should grind away a minor share.

Second Race 1. Rip Riding Away 12. Style in Time 2 Dorotea Dream

RIP RIDING AWAY drops to the lowest level of her career after stalking a wire-to-wire winner while being caught wide throughout back on November 29. Trainer Kathleen O'Connell adds the blinkers for the first time on this daughter of Palace Malice, who is likely to get an aggressive ride out of her inside draw by jokey Hector Diaz Jr. This should lead to a favorable forward position and her first trip to the winner's circle. STYLE IN TIME makes her second career start after disappointing against slightly better on debut for owner/trainer Juan Arraigada. I am willing to forgive the effort to an extent because she was drawn down on the rail. This forced her hand and led to her tiring badly. The move to an outside draw should allow her to relax more in the early stages.

Third Race 2 Sa Sa Sa 9. Tiz Lord 5. Milchin

Fifth Race 9. Cherbourg 8. Jenas Mercy 2 Tourist Style

Sixth Race 6 Sassy Charlee 2 Wait a Sec 9. Marvelous Lady

Seventh Race 2. Political Riot /a. Initforthelove 8. H C Holiday

POLITICAL RIOT stretches out to a route of ground after a pair of one-turn events off the freshening for trainer David Van Winkle. The son of Two Step Salsa finds a field with very little speed signed on. He should have no issue making the lead from his inside draw under jockey Chad Lindsay and taking them all the way on the engine. INITFORTHELOVE has won eight times in his career, but has seemingly lacked the will to win as a seven-year-old evidenced by his 0 for 11-record in 2024. He was caught wide throughout much of the way last out when losing by a neck as the 2-1-public choice, but is likely to take too much money for me to support on the Win end. H C HOLIDAY ships back down to Florida after racing at Woodbine since the middle of May for trainer Michael Wright. He has shown an affinity for this course and Wright has a \$2.87 ROI at Tampa over a 54-race sample size the last two years.

Eighth Race **3**. Golden Juan **6**. Cupid's Dude **5**. Street Glide

GOLDEN JUAN returns to the races for the first time since mid-September when he set the pace against starter allowance foes at Delaware Park and tired badly to finish sixth. The son of Fed Biz failed to win this spring and summer up north, but should love getting back to a racetrack he has won 4 of 7 over in his career. His trainer Juan Avila is off to a strong start again and thrives at this meet. In fact, he has clicked at a 24%-win rate over the last two years for an incredibly strong \$3.38 ROI. This five-year-old gelding takes them all the way under jockey Sonny Leon. CUPID'S DUDE makes his first start since an off the pace second over the Gulfstream Park all-weather. The Jose Gallegos trainee should be finishing well off of a potential contentious first-half mile. STREET GLIDE has never won over this surface, but has hit the board in 4 of 5, including four straight runner-up performances to end last year's meet. There is no reason to believe he won't pick up the pieces again here.

Ninth Race **9**. Linny Kate **3**. E M's Treasuregirl **4** Vingativa

The pace should be honest in this \$16k claimer, which bodes well for LINNY KATE. The seven-year-old mare has been off nearly two-months since her fifth-place effort over the Gulfstream Park grass. She did not get out of the gates well that day and tired badly after a bit of a middle move, but meets a group she is capable of handling here in her first start for trainer John Rigattieri. Hopefully, jockey Pablo Morales can angle over early to save ground. If so, she should be able to run them down late. E M'S TREASUREGIRL is easily the likeliest to hit the board in the finale, but has been camera shy throughout her 18-race career. She won by a head versus lesser two-back, but her nine seconds tell you all you need to know. VINGATIVA has never finished worse than second in two starts over this turf course. If they go at it early, she will be rolling late.

The Friday card features an allowance sprint that drew a trio of Grade 3 winners, while another Grade 3 winner, Lemon Muffin, goes in an allowance route for fillies and mares. In the opener, GREAT BARRIER gets a chance with Arkansas-breds with the meet now on at Oaklawn and he's been representing himself quite well against open foes. TIME ANDBEYOND makes his first start since last season at Oaklawn and he fired some competitive local races. GETOUTYOURWALLET gets his first test with Arkansas-breds.

Second Race **1.** Perfect Dial 5 Gee No Hollander 3. Little Randy

PERFECT DIAL gets his first opportunity against Arkansas-breds with the return of racing at Oaklawn. The race he exits has become a key one, with the third-place finisher coming back to take a maiden allowance at RP with a Beyer of 69 and the 11th-place finisher, Boss Down, a \$10K maiden claimer at RP, with a Beyer of 34. GEE NO HOLLANDER caught a wet track last time when debuting against open foes at Ind. LITTLE RANDY has moved forward from his first start to his second.

LEMON MUFFIN is the class of the field as a Grade 3 winner and the effort came at this distance at Oaklawn in last season's Honeybee. As for the race she ran second in last time, note it's fourth-place finisher returned to win an allowance Sunday at Oaklawn.

Eighth Race 5. Ain't That a Kick 8. Own the Field 6 Cawkab




