Race 1 #1 BRZINA played the fade in her most recent, but on the whole, it's difficult to argue with 14 Exacta finishes from 21 career starts on a fast track. Jockey/Trainer combination do better together than apart, and this miss is two for four when first to load on a glib surface. Big shot if able to grab an easy lead. #3 SHE'SALITTLEEDGY is another one with a lifetime penchant for hitting the top two placings, and could contest the above for the front end. #4 KITTEN'S APPEAL has been beset by back to back off lines, but has never been entered this cheaply, and has partaken in the superfecta in all five pairings with today's pilot.

Race 2 #5 ST. BENEDICT'S PREP is an extremely consistent sort who has been a part of the superfecta in 15 straight outings where the jock has stayed aboard, and that includes solid performances right here, beneath today's pilot, and when last to load. We like this one's ability to send or rate just a bit, and we feel the race goes through her. #3 NEVER WALK ALONE has traversed the San Isidro/Hippodromo/Churchill/Ellis/Kentucky Downs/Turfway route to get to Ozone Park this afternoon, and as she is a half length shy of having an unblemished two for two mark on the brown stuff, we see no reason to dismiss. #1 SUNDAY GIRL completes the only three we'll be using for our rolling wagers, based on the perfect five for five record on a track labeled FST, with speed figure improvement along the way.

Race 3 #3 BAM'S BLISS KISS hasn't been seen since finishing in the back half of the pack back in Mid December, & after being off the work tab for about 5 weeks afterwards, is displaying back to back bullets for today's return. Lasix is now a part of the makeup, and it's always encouraging to see the pre layoff pilot return. #2 D'S A ROCK is another one getting the miracle drug now, and also has blinkers affixed while switching from an apprentice to a journeyman in today's first start off the snag. #6 VALTELLINA makes her second start off the bench after flopping last out, and could perk up with blinkers added..

Race 4 #3 LONG LEGGED QUEEN returned off a bit of a freshening to finish second in her 2nd time on the main, and can improve off of the speed figure earned that day in today's first true second time off a layoff. #7 MULKEY has been sidelined, but hit the board in both outings before being shelved, and like we alluded to in an earlier race, it's always nice to see the pre-break pilot come back. #2 SHE'S WICKED SMART has been in the money in three of her last four calls to the post, but we are going to leave beneath, has Falcone is 0 for his last 23.

Race 5 We have a couple of tidy but tight Formulator stats in play for today's fifth race, 5 ROMEO VOID has improved from a speed figure standpoint over his last three, culminating with a troubled but honest third place finish versus softer last week. Green is two of two with those who hit the board more than 22 days ago, with the winners returning \$3 & \$8, and we'll make this one a tepid choice in a race with but one first draft toss. #6 OUTSORCE received the unkindest cut of all most likely directly after the recent showing, as he was back on the work tab just two and a half weeks later, shedrow is four or four with maiden special wight male entrants off breaks of 29-34 days. Recognize the big switch in the irons this afternoon. #2 HOME INVASION begins his career today, and does such with some stamina building breezes on the synthetic, and a couple of others at 6 furlongs, which should have him well prepped for today's debut at a mile.

Race 6 #6 POPPY'S PRIDE closed out the triple against similar type at Philadelphia Park last time out, and as this one is historically approximately 10% better on a dry track than one with moisture in it, you can feel free to upgrade that BSF accordingly. War horse has done decent work right here, and goes from a bug to a vet today. #4 SCARAMANGA is confidently hiked up the ladder despite being kept in jail after the recent purchase, and totes the lightest impost of his career now. Eligible to rebound off the last. #7 BORRACHO is a perennial win machine, as this bay is on a five race winning streak on a fast surface.

Race 7 #2 MAJESTIC FRONTIER was an honest runnerup finisher in this race 23 days in the rear, and although she's winless on a wet track, she is historically 27.2% better on fast going, so right off the bat we expect to see some improvement in that regards. From a trainer stat point of view, Dally is three for four with locally based mid level dirt stock who hit the board less than seven weeks back, at 7-1 or beneath. The winners returned \$14, \$12, and \$5, and this boy could do with some pace to cut into. #4 KHAFRE has been kept in prison since being purchased on 1/19, & returns back at the same level today, while getting an 80 oz. reduction in the weight department. #1 HE'S GOT THIS has been camera shy over his last nine treks to the frontside, but barn enlists the services of one of their go to jocks, and could improve with today's drop in class.

Race 8 #1 I'M BUZZY looks very tough and very logical, down the lane. #5 SAVE US MELANIA appears to have the best shot of upsetting the above, based on her 3:1-1-1 record in dirt starts off a L/O. #2 TONED UP has been a part of the super in her last eight one turn engagements, but we are going to keep in the unders because of her winless mark in this ZIP code.

Race 9 #8 FLUFF THE PILLOW has been befallen by back-to-back layoff lines, but overcame a slow start to post an adjusted 71 in his only local start on a fast track, and that came at a higher level, from an outside post position, and without the use of a hood or Lasix -- both of such which are now a part of the makeup. You may get some value here for a fella who has never been entered at this level. #1 TRUE CONNECTION makes all kinds of sense given the overall body of work, but is beginning to give the impression of becoming "that" kind of maiden. #7 TIZ THE PRINCE has lost his procreating abilities since last facing the starter, but owns a couple of decent running lines and may perk up in his first try against open foes.

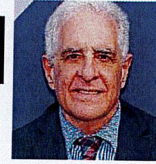

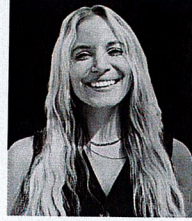

RACE 1: 2 FAINOR'S FILETS is dropping from starter/optional-claiming company to meet \$7.5K conditioned opposition and should get back on the beam with Hamilton gaining the mount. 4 SWEET HEIDELBERG rode a speed bias last time before coming up empty in the lane when obviously overmatched in the one-mile Nellie Morse Stakes. She prevailed the time before while sprinting in the lower claiming ranks when on Lasix. 5 LOVING CUP rarely runs a bad one and should be included in the lower rungs of the exotics.

Race 2 2 HAPPY HOUR JOKER has a number of improvement angles going for her, most notably the drop from maiden special company, along with first-time blinkers and Lasix. She could wire this group at a chalky price. 1 TUNED TO THE MOON looks next best off a troubled second at first asking in a longer sprint at this level over a muddy strip. Magee has solid numbers with maiden second-timers. 5 LASS SASSENACH is acquiring Lasix off a fade job in a two-turn experiment in December and her trainer has impressive numbers off a claim.

Race 3 7 AUTHENTICATED is by the low 6% first-out sire Authentic, whose offspring tend to be late developers. Russell has been on fire with her firsters of late, however, and this homebred is debuting for a pittance against a seemingly modest field. 4 MISS SERAFINA was a well-beaten second behind the favorite at first asking for a trainer possessing low recent numbers with maiden second-timers. 6 FIRING THOUGHTS has worked quickly on occasion for a 20% debut trainer and should be considered if live in the betting.

Race 4 1 EDGE OF TOWN came from fourth for second over a speed-friendly track when boosted up to this N1X level as the favorite Feb. 7. Leading rider JRod retains the mount for a trainer with whom he's had ample success. 2 PINOTSLILGIRL rode a speed bias in the slop when romping in a recent starter/optional claimer, earning a big but inflated 81 Beyer in the process. Her tactical speed may come in handy in her third try off a claim. 4 CRUSADER RABBIT wouldn't be any surprise as she exits a vacation for the red-hot Russell, who has a 30% strike rate with six-month-plus comebackers.

Race 5

1 COMPLEXITY JANE rallied inside over a speed-favoring track to land her six-furlong debut after a rocky start Feb. 1. She's bred to handle the stretch-out to a mile and could strike again, even though Russell has mediocre numbers with second-timers exiting a first-out score. 4 MAD FOR MADDY has won two straight one-turn miles, vs. maidens here and against \$50K starter/optional-claiming stock at Aqueduct. The Florida-bred is versatile in terms of running style and will take some beating if she continues to improve. 6 ESTOCADA dusted \$30K maidens when moving out from three-quarters to a mile in her second trip postward and probably isn't out of her league in this acid test.

Race 6

2 ENERGY EFFICIENT went to the bench after getting claimed from a flat performance at this \$7.5K class Dec. 27--the runner-up came right back to win at the same level with a 65 Beyer. His trainer had a 20% strike rate off the claim during the past five years (\$1.98 ROI) and his recent stats with that angle are even better. 1 HELIUM is descending from \$16K conditioned company at Aqueduct to a new low and will form a chalky entry with Walk Away Joe if they both start. 3 MASTER OF NONE got back on track when second on the drop to this level three weeks ago when apprentice Rodriguez rode him for the first time.

Race 7

BEST BET 7 SHAFT'S BULLET had earned three straight Beyers in the low 90s, culminating with a nose loss in a stakes at Delaware, when he went to the sidelines in July. The six-time winner has a history of firing when fresh and his trainer won at a 28% clip with six-month-plus layoff runners going back five years (\$3.91 ROI). 8 ROMINSKI , another fast comebacker, should be favored in his second try off a \$55K claim by the hot leading trainer Russell. He's been working bullets and is strictly the one to catch. 3 DEBIT CARD received a 91 Beyer when notching an open allowance two back, but wasn't as sharp most recently in the mud. Use him underneath in the gimmicks on a fast track.

Race 8

6 ON A PROUD NOTE is dropping sharply with the addition of Lasix following a layoff and may have found a field that she can beat. Trombetta scored at a 16% rate with maiden third-time starters over the past five years (\$1.59 ROI). 4 BORN CHARMER comes off a distant second in the mud in her improved second outing and should be a player. 2 NOEL'S DREAM wasn't beaten far for second when third after racing wide in her opener and could round out the tri.

BEST BET: Rocket Night (10th race)

First Race **3**. Sulwe **1** Gold Strategy **7**. Lady Woopig

Highlights of the card include the Nodouble Stakes and an allowance route for 3-year-olds. In the opener, SULWE is moving back into the Arkansas-bred ranks following a credible start against open foes. She also returns to racing over the distance of her last win on form. GOLD STRATEGY might be sitting on a peak race in her third start since August. LADY WOOPIG is proven around two turns at Oaklawn.

Second Race **1**. Spin the Breeze **8**. Thorn Crown **9**. Ifuaintfirsturlast

SPIN THE BREEZE is appealing from a class standpoint as she has lined up against higher-priced foes. She also could be sitting on a peak effort in this, her third out since August. THORN CROWN has been knocking on the door against similar. IFUAINTFIRSTURLAST is a new face to the market as she has been racing in Southern California.

Third Race **5** Django **7**. Moneyshot **4** Brave Blend

DJANGO is back on dirt after the synthetic track start and his maiden win came on dirt. MONEYSHOT figures to make good use of the added ground he picks up on the move to two turns. BRAVE BLEND returns to racing on the main track, site of his maiden win, after a pair of turf starts in Southern California.

Fourth Race **1**. Ain't That a Kick **10**. Big Drinker **2** Aaron

This appears to be a well-matched group of horses. AIN'T THAT A KICK could find himself closer to the pace that he was last time on account of the move from a mile to a mile and a sixteenth. BIG DRINKER must overcome the widest post, but owns one of the field's best last-race Beyer Speed Figures. AARON can be closer to the pace than some of these. MIGHTY MESSAGE has run some races that would likely land him in the winner's circle in this spot.

Fifth Race **5** Simovic **1** Walstib **6**. Nyquist Frequency

SIMOVIC has been a consistent force and he could be sitting on a peak effort in the third start of his form cycle. WALSTIB cuts back to one turn after showing speed around two, and that can be an effective move with a horse. NYQUIST FREQUENCY is back on dirt, site of his best career Beyer Speed Figures.

Sixth Race **5** Baby Gundin **4** Butterfly Queen **6** Saranac Lake

BABY GUNDIN is appealing as an eight-time winner. BUTTERFLY QUEEN is making her third start since November. SARANAC LAKE gets in light under apprentice Bacon.

Seventh Race **1** Bohemian Bo **7** Midnight Taxes **3** Lochmoor

BOHEMIAN BO defends his title in the Nodouble. He's moving back into the statebred ranks following a pair of strong races against open foes, including a win in good time in December. MIDNIGHT TAXES has speed and a post that might give Bejarano options. LOCHMOOR can take advantage if the fractions get too hot up front. More on each of the entrants in the Closer Look feature in Daily Racing Form.

Eighth Race **5** Velociraptor **2** Semper Invictus **8** Trouble's Roaring

VELOCIRAPTOR was prominent throughout last time in a strong seasonal debut. The race went in good time. SEMPER INVICTUS makes his first start at Oaklawn after being based in Southern California. He's had a chance to work over the local strip. TROUBLE'S ROARING is back on dirt, site of his best career Beyer Speed Figures. More on each of the entrants in the Closer Look feature in Daily Racing Form.

Ninth Race **3** McDude **7** First Division **1** Landing Craft

MCDUDE was just edged at this distance in his most recent out and for the effort he earned what ranks as this field's best last-race Beyer Speed Figure. One start prior he faced Sandman, who went on to run second in the Southwest and third in the Rebel. FIRST DIVISION exits same race as top choice, finishing a close third. It was this one's two-turn debut. LANDING CRAFT ran a credible race last out in his first start against winners.

Tenth Race **7** Rocket Night **12** Chou Chou d'Aven **8** Unnecessary Tricks

ROCKET NIGHT is very appealing for his highly consistent nature. CHOU CHOU D'AVEN appears to be working his way into the winner's circle. UNNECESSARY TRICKS moved back to two turns last out and ran a credible third.

BEST BET: Lady Gregory (9th race)

First Race **1**. Cupid's Crusader **4**. Be Punctual **6**. Bowtie Boys

CUPID'S CRUSADER drops to the lowest level for SoCal-based winners (\$16k claiming N2) and returns to dirt after facing better on turf. The surface switch should be fine; he won a maiden dirt sprint here last spring and finished second in a two-turn dirt race against winners last summer at Del Mar. A late-runner, 'CRUSADER can wear them down. But he'll have to catch BE PUNCTUAL, who finished second (disqualified, placed third) last out in a similar N2L claiming route. 'PUNCTUAL has a forwardly placed running style that should play well in a race that could unfold at a relatively slow pace. BOWTIE BOYS ran races last fall that are fast enough for this group, he did not have a fair shot in his recent comeback. He was racing above his eligibility in a N3L claiming race, broke slowly, and was wide throughout. Now he drops to N2L with a prep under his belt. Improvement likely.

Second Race **3**. Attracted **5**. Rousing Jewel **1** Halfway to Nowhere

ATTRACTED is a tepid choice in this filly-mare allowance/optional claiming sprint for Northern California horses/horsemen. She won her first two starts impressively at Pleasanton, followed by an eventful trip at Santa Anita, runner-up at odds-on. ATTRACTED stumbled at the break and got slammed by a rival, lost position, raced in traffic and missed by a half-length. The bad break gives her an alibi, it seems curious she now shows up eligible to be claimed for \$32k (per the overnight). ATTRACTED is the "best" filly in the field, but a likely underlay. ROUSING JEWEL is a five-time winner with speed making her first start in two and a half months. She was listed as a vet scratch Jan. 17, but worked regularly since and runs well fresh. She will be in front of the top choice early.

Third Race **6** Starts Now **1** Speed Lane **2** Ms Brightside

STARTS NOW must run better than last out in order to win this N3L starter on turf, but her runner-up finish at this level two back gives her the edge stretching from eight to nine furlongs. The "trouble" she had last out was minor; she was flat. She tries a rider switch to Flavien Prat, and is likely to be forwardly placed in a distance race that should unfold at a soft tempo.

Fourth Race **4**. Memosis **1**. Jolie Candy **6**. Little Silver Girl

This Cal-bred maiden-50 is a total raffle. MEMOSIS showed enough ability in her third-place debut last June to rate the advantage. She rallied to third, worked twice after, and then was sidelined four months. She has not missed a drill since her work pattern began in late November, and she returns for a claim tag this afternoon.

Fifth Race **7**. Strate Cash **2**. Cajun Gold **6**. Going Viral

STRATE CASH is bred to win early, his fast works at San Luis Rey Downs suggest he is ready to fire. Debut progeny of Tiz the Law are 9 for 53 (16 percent); 'CASH also is bred to win early on the bottom side. His stakes-winning dam won first out; each of her first three runners hit the board first out including a debut winner. Although maidens trained by Richard Baltas typically race into shape rather than fire first out, fast works and the presence of a top rider suggest 'CASH will come out firing. CAJUN GOLD is better than his most recent start suggests. He dueled for the lead early, which is against his typical running style. His best race was an off-slow, fast-finish runner-up two back. Expect him to ration his speed more efficiently this time, and put in his typical honest run. Prior to his last-start misfire, he finished second in all three starts.

Sixth Race **3**. Supa Speed **5**. Maysam **4**. Cipriani

Stakes-placed turf filly SUPA SPEED switches to dirt in this G3 route; her main-track works suggest the surface switch is fine. The main question is how she will react to kickback; she is likely to be positioned in the rear flight. 'SPEED is by multi-surface stallion Justify, though her dam raced exclusively on grass. Based on her turf races against good company and her dirt works, the most accomplished filly in the field gets the call to rally for the win. MAYSAM wheels back two weeks after misfiring in a \$250k stakes at Sunland Park. She acted up in the gate, broke poorly, and sputtered to finish sixth at 1-to-10. But her debut win on SA dirt two back was a six-length romp. She worked an easy three-eighths here Wednesday; her trainer's starters typically do well running back on short notice. Since summer 2021, Bob Baffert is 8 for 20 wheeling back in 14 to 16 days. MAYSAM has more speed than she showed last out.

Seventh Race **3**. Silver N Black **2**. Mr Fabricator **1**. Mongolian Champ

The 15-start maiden SILVER N BLACK is the tepid choice in this weak maiden-20 dirt mile. His best races have been long on dirt; he stretches out from an okay fourth-place sprint. MR FABRICATOR drops from maiden-50 and returns to dirt

Eighth Race **12**. Abadon **10**. Right Hand Ryder **7**. Contrary Chieftain

Also-eligible ABADON would start from the far outside in this \$5k claiming mile, but the post is not insurmountable. He overcame a tough post (9 of 9) last out winning a similar race.;If ABADON reproduces his last-out win over the SA track, he can make it two straight despite the draw. Otherwise,

Ninth Race **7**. Lady Gregory **1**. Nanci Griffith **8**. Long Mayshe Reign

LADY GREGORY can make amends in this Cal-bred allowance turf sprint after finishing fourth at even-money. She never had a chance. A nine-time winner, she was blocked from the quarter pole to deep stretch. It was a toss race. Her runner-up finish two back would be fast enough, she only needs a clean trip to deliver as most probable winner on the day.

Tenth Race **8**. Billy Joe Shaver **7**. Cody Boy **5**. Blazing Peme

BILLY JOE SHAVER wheels back in a week after a sharp runner-up finish on turf. He can run on the main track; he won a maiden-20 dirt race here two starts ago.

Eleventh Race **1** Eye On Ry **6**. Maniac **8**. Grand Aspen

EYE ON RY has improved since relocating from the Midwest. His runner-up finish last out at this N2X class level was flattered when winner El Potente wheeled back to win a G3 next out and was entered as one of the favorites in a G1 on Saturday.
