2 RISING INFLATION had an easy time on the lead when breaking her maiden over this track and trip last June with a field-best 85 Beyer; looked like she might have needed that last one off the layoff when not showing speed after a bump at the start before getting tired.

Race 3 5-3-1

5 CATCHPHRASE was only second-best without excuse when improving to a 66 Beyer in her second career start; posted an easy front-running win when lefty along on the lead to break her maiden two back, then looked like she was in over her head in the allowance ranks last time; drops down with speed. 3 SHE'S COOL ran an odd race off the claim in January, then bumped into a dominant winner when dropped to this level going a mile in her next start - Patty Van Twinkle earned an 81 Beyer for that won, and has since paired-up 85s in two starts vs tougher competition; was back up in class last time when chasing gamely all the way before just missing second; steps back a bit and Franco sticks

4 Collect Dattt 2 Brzina 1 Spiritual Lady

Race 5 1 Bookitwithhaddad 5 Strand Road 6 Twenty One Kid

A lack of early speed is a concern with likely favorite 1 BOOKITWITHHADDAD , particularly when taking that last one into account, as she tried to keep up close to the pace early in that spot and was unable to do so; she does own the top figure in the field, which was earned the last time she started over this surface, and she is dropping in class for this. 5 STRAND ROAD like a few of his rivals he tried winners for the first time in his last start to no avail; not only was that his first try against winners, it came for twice this tag; showed some speed before hitting the brakes; surely can benefit from the drop and he returns to the site of his 2 best races including his lone win.

Race 6 5 Macaw 2 Very Satisfactory 7 Remember the Chief

5 MACAW-3-time beaten favorite has been away since breaking poorly and did not finish at SAR; 6 published workouts since last ; he is capable on best; 3-back represents the field's-best Beyer defeating the show finisher who posted a 78 speed figure in his next-out PRX-MSW victory. 2 VERY SATISFACTORY has hit the board in all five dirt starts to date without breaking through, and he has gone favored in four of those races; was back on two weeks rest when only second-best at a very short price going this distance last time; tries again. 7 REMEMBER THE CHIEF was caught outside keeping after the pace in a race that went to closers when dropped to this level at Saratoga; was laid up after that and likely got a lot out of that sprint last time when contesting the pace before tiring with the waiver in place; back out to a mile for his second start off the bench.

Race 7 3 Rungius 4 Peek 5 Good Skate

3 RUNGIUS -Has the speed to be in it from the start and he's shown before he can carry it going at least this far; pressed the pace before fading here last month but not only did he use fuel early it was his first start in 10 months so giving way was understandable; It came at this level and they keep him at the same level, which encourages; worked super since and as noted he's proven going this far.

4 PEEK- Dull here Dec. 28 but not only was that off a layoff it came in slop; it also came sprinting; moved to 9fs for his next 2 here and perked up nicely with a 1st and a 2nd; the latter came at the hands of a sharp horse at this level; nice to see no drop and he's got speed and while it's a new, longer game he's bred for it and acts as though he'll handle it.

5 GOOD SKATE was in good form on dirt back in 2023 before Maker tried to make him a long-distance turf horse; has been a bit inconsistent since returning to this surface, though he did win over this distance last February, and he was game to prevail in that last one while first back from a long layoff; capable with or without the lead, handles fast or wet dirt, and stretching back out is no issue.

Race 8 5 Welcome Back Babe 2 Sky Runner 9 Ah Ca Ira

5 WELCOME BACK BABE Its been more than 8 months since a dull effort when stretched out to 1 Mile for the 1st time; racing 2nd-time Long is often an improvement angle; capable on best; 2-back represents the field's-best Beyer; pressed the pace at shorter in some of her losses; know her early then hopes to hang on late .

2 SKY RUNNER Exits a key race in a much tougher-open race posting a career-low Beyer as the show and 5th-place finishers posted 48-57 speed figures in next-out AQU-30K-maiden claiming and AQU-maiden-optional claiming graduations; racing 2nd-time Long is often an improvement angle; pressed the pace vs. the 2-back winner who Beyered 73 in a next-out AQU-allowance victory.

9 AH CA IRA lost early position before finishing a distant third when stretched out on New Year's Day; ran better than it looks in her next start when involved on a contested pace and getting caught late by a closer; was only second-best when improving to a new Beyer top last time, though Tower Twenty Two did come back to win again

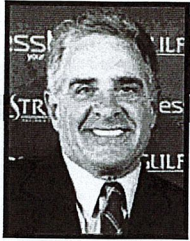

RACE 1:

4 OTTO is turning back to three-quarters of a mile after surrendering a late lead when finishing second behind a repeat winner going seven furlongs. Carlos David has Edgard Zayas named to ride. **5 DAVID'S SONG** is back vs two lifetime claimers after skipping a condition and finishing fifth vs \$8,000 three lifetime foes at the distance Trainer Jennifer Young has Edgar Perez in the saddle. **3 GRAND AVILA** is dropping to this level in the first race since failing to fire vs \$17,500 claimers going five furlongs on the Tapeta. Victor Barboza Jr has Paco Lopez at the controls.

SELECTIONS: 4-5-3

RACE 2:

7 CLOSE UP moves to the Kent Sweezey barn and steps up after finishing a game second vs \$50,000 maidens going five panels on the all-weather surface. **6 SHE'S A GAMER** is debuting on the Tapeta at five and a half furlongs with blinkers added after showing speed and fading late vs special weight runners going three-quarters of a mile on the dirt. Mark Casse has Edwin Gonzalez atop the daughter of Game Winner. **3 AS ADVERTISED** is a \$185,000 daughter of War of Will debuting for Mark Casse with Lasix and Edgard Zayas named to ride this half of his uncoupled entry.

SELECTIONS: 7-6-3

RACE 3:

2 GIFTEDBYDESIGN, an okay fourth going long on the Tapeta two starts back, is going back to the all-weather surface showing late interest when finishing seventh – beaten one ½ lengths – going seven and a half furlongs on the turf. Trainer Jose D'Angelo is 23% with the surface switch. **3 SIGAN VIENDO** is dropping to the \$35,000 level with Lasix added after showing early interest, going seven furlongs on the main track in his only race as a two-year-old. **5 RISK FACTOR** debuts locally on the Tapeta after facing better on the Oaklawn main track with limited success. The tote action should tell us more about this Mark Casse/Rajiv Maragh collaboration.

SELECTIONS: 2-3-5

RACE 4:

5 HALA BLUE (IRE) is dropping to the \$35,000 level after failing to show much in her North American debut vs \$75,000 optional claimers going a mile on the grass. Trainer Brendan Walsh adds second-time Lasix and jockey Jorge Ruiz for the class drop. **1 BETTER THAN BETTER** is turning back to a mile after becoming the only two-time winner in the field when defeating \$35,000 claimers going a mile and a sixteenth on the turf. **2 MAJESTIC DRIVE**, another from Brendan Walsh, is debuting on the turf after responding to the dropdown in competition with a rousing four-length victory vs \$25,000 maidens going a mile and seventy yards on the Tapeta. Edgard Zayas rides.

SELECTIONS: 5-1-2

RACE 5:

1 NANDO has his claiming tag carved in half after closing to finish third vs \$25,000 two lifetime runners going five and a half furlongs on the Tapeta. Fernando Abreu has Jesus Rios managing the inside draw.

5 ROAD TO VERSAILLES should be primed and ready to score after debuting locally for the red-hot Marty Drexler barn and finishing second vs \$8,000 claimers. Edwin Gonzales rides. **3 OUR LEGAL TENDER** is looking to find a tad more after returning from the extended layoff to finish third – as the favorite – at this level and distance. Trainer Jorge Delgado is 25% with the second start back from this type of layoff.

SELECTIONS: 1-5-3**RACE 6:**

1 ROXY drops and turns back to six and a half furlongs after dueling for the lead and tiring to finish sixth vs maiden special weight runners going a mile and a sixteenth. Carlos David has Edgard Zayas quarterbacking the classic turnback move. **3 R PRETTY KITTY** is a daughter of Instilled Regard debuting for Saffie Joseph Jr with Lasix and apprentice Micha Husbands named to ride. The tote action should tell us more. **4 BE THANKFUL** is stepping up into the big leagues with blinkers added after posting a competitive speed figure in her \$12,500 debut. The recent half-mile bullet workout indicates she might be up to the task ahead.

SELECTIONS: 1-3-4**RACE 7:**

2 SOUPER DORMY is dropping after debuting locally for Marty Drexler and finishing a chase the pace fifth in a fruitful \$35,000 optional claimer that has produced a pair of next-out winners from three starters. Edwin Gonzalez rides.

1 BLESS AMERICA, now in the Saffie Joseph Jr barn, the gelding makes his first start since drawing clear to defeat allowance runners on the Presque Isle Tapeta. The barn, 30% with new additions to the shedrow, has go-to jock Edgard Zayas at the controls.

6 TAKECAREOFBUSINESS, a rallying third at this level and distance last out, can end up sitting in the catbird seat behind the swift pace scenario expected. Trainer Jeff Santiago has Jonathan Ocasio in the saddle.

SELECTIONS: 2-1-6**RACE 8:**

5 MALDINI is dropping to the \$25,000 level and turning back to a mile after stepping up off the claim and failing to fire vs maiden special weight competition going a taxing nine furlongs. Trainer Bill Tharrenos has Paco Lopez atop the son of Vino Rosso.

8 DREAM SCHEME, a \$300,000 son of Quality Road moves the Sam Wilensky barn via the claim and returns to the turf with blinkers added after coming within a neck of defeating \$25,000 maidens going a mile and seventy yards on the Tapeta. Edgar Perez rides. **2 SPONGE TIME** is another going back to the grass after rallying to finish third – a neck behind Dream Scheme last out. Trainer Aubrey Maragh has Rajiv Maragh atop the son of Hard Spun.

SELECTIONS: 5-8-2

Hawthorne Race 1

Post Time 2:40 PM CST

4 Lemon Bomb - 7/2 **3** Raceday Attire - 6/1 **5** Pioneer Parade - 5/2

After a day of rain on Wednesday, things look to be good on Thursday as the track surface at Hawthorne drains very well. The opener is competitive as I'll give the nod to 4-LEMON BOMB in here. Equibase speed figures are notoriously inflated in synthetic surface races so you need to look back to the dirt, where Lemon Bomb was sharp and consistent in dirt sprints in 2024. She has speed, runs for a high percentage barn, and picks up Felix in the saddle. 3-RACEDAY ATTIRE could be a bit of a sleeper in here as she has had past Hawthorne success. She makes her first start of the year off a couple of drills, but could benefit if Pioneer Parade goes with Lemon Bomb early. 5-PIONEER PARADE ships in with speed as she merits a look as well. Loveberry picks up the mount as he is primed for a good meet. She's another with past conventional dirt form who will take her share of action.

Hawthorne Race 2

3 Good to Be Prince - 3/1 **1** Carambaso - 9/5 **2** Better Than Good - 4/1

A good bunch to kick off the Early Pick 4. 3GOOD TO BE PRINCE runs for the hot Rodriguez barn as everything has been live to open the meet. Mitch Murrill is riding very well as this one should get a perfect stalking trip. 1-CARAAMBASO is the one to beat as he has speed and has been competitive against tough company this meet. It looks like he is at his best on a fast track, which he should catch after the rainy Wednesday. 2-BETTER THAN GOOD makes his 2025 debut off a good string of drills, including a bullet work on March 19. He won in his first career start last summer and likely bled in his second race. He gets Lasix in here and may be sitting on a big race.

Hawthorne Race 3

5 Coalminer's Kitten - 7/2 **2** Red Label - 8/1 **1** Supremely - 3/1

A good starter group with numerous runners in with a shot. Trainer Max Quinonez has a nice win last Sunday here and has 5-COALMINER'S KITTEN in here for his first start on the year. He closed out 2024 on a high note and has run well over this track in this past. He will need pace to chase and should find it in this spot. 2-RED LABEL grabbed a couple of Hawthorne victories last summer before taking some time off after his July start. He has just one work on the year so he may need a start, but the price makes him one that is worth a look. 1-SUPREMEPLY was a sharp winner in his first off the claim last out. He showed improved speed in that start and drew clear late. Let's see if he wings it from the rail once again.

Hawthorne Race 4

5 Purple Octopus - 8/5 **6** Cupid's War - 3/1 **3** Ancient Man - 12/1

While likely the best in the field, 5-PURPLE OCTOPUS is skipping a condition for this race but runs for top connections. He has been away since last June but was brought to New Orleans this winter and has trained consistently toward his return. There's not much pace in this race as I expect he is sent away early and looks to wire this field. 6-CUPID'S WAR was a good winner here last week as he rated close and drew clear in the lane. There wasn't much pace in that race as he figures to be in a stalking position in here. 3-ANCIENT MAN may be the price play as he ran a decent race around two turns here last week. Fitness doesn't look to be an issue as he should be closing late in this sprint spot.

Hawthorne Race 5

3 Star of Kodiak - 4/1 **1** Lord Grantham - 9/2 **2** Justice Once - 6/1

Right back to a Quinonez runner in the fifth as there could be some value in this spot. Looking to 3-STAR OF KODIAK as he makes his first start of the year off a couple of drills. He has won five times over this Hawthorne strip and has been solid at this distance. He figures to rate and run on late, so we will see if there's enough pace to chase. 1-LORD GRANTHAM could rate close from the inside. He has just the one work but Martinez typically has his ready to roll. I expect he is forwardly placed and could hang around if there isn't much early pace pressure. 2-JUSTICE ONCE shortens up as he has worked well toward his return. He may need to hustle a bit for early position in here but figures to run on in the lane.

Hawthorne Race 6

3 Summer of Mischief - 3/1 **7** Kiki Krazy - 4/1 **5** Aldora - 5/2

A good allowance bunch with a couple with early speed. One of those with pace is 3-SUMMER OF MISCHIEF as she comes in off a sharp effort in her first race off the claim. If you dig deeper into her past performances, you will see good dirt races at Churchill, which should put her right there in the mix with these. 7-KIKI KRAZY is one that figures to run on late as she sprints for her second straight start. She got a work over the track since her last start as everything from the Tracy barn looks ready to roll. 5-ALDORA has tactical speed as she should get a good stalking trip in here. She's been sharp in a pair of Hawthorne starts and just needs another to go after Summer of Mischief early to help her chances.

Hawthorne Race 7

2 Arrivederci - 2/1 **8** Smoked - 9/5 **1** Lions Law - 5/1

Looks like Rivelli could go 1-2 in here as it is just a matter of which way they run. Because she has the start under her belt, let's look to 2-ARRIVEDERCCI as she adds Lasix for her second career start. She debuted here last summer and ran well. She trained through the winter in New Orleans and should be a different racehorse now. 8-SMOKED debuts from the outside as she has a nice pattern of drills coming into today's start. She gets Lasix first out and picks up Loveberry in the saddle. 1-LIONS LAW has run close and figures to break her maiden soon. She has tactical speed and will take advantage of the rail that is drying out.

DANDY DAY just won and did so nicely at 26-1. Is this guy a horse for course before anyone knows it? Is he a new route horse? What if this guy got a taste of winning and liked it? Win rider stays put and connections wisely want a mile right back. PAISLEES PROMISE has some speed and is feeling great with back to back Beyer tops. New barn is 1 for 5 off the claim. We like that Americano stays put. There is other speed in this race if looking for a knock. MONGOLIAN FROST just ran better and did so in his first try going this distance and on this surface. Did this horse learn to pass runners in his most recent? He is often a great price.

Fourth Race 6-5-1-4

CLASSY LASS is feeling great, can get the distance, figures a good trip, loves this sod, and goes for a 19% turf barn. There is good speed in this race but this horse has passed runners before. LOVE ALIVE ran a Beyer top in her last two turf starts. We like that she puts three races together and returns to a turf route. Win rider stays put as this filly once again ships in from Los Angeles. PINK SOLITAIRE is the fresh face from Sam Houston where the turf racing is good. Her new barn is 35% on the grass. The rail draw is a plus and we wouldn't be shocked if this mare showed speed. Don't forget that the first turn comes up here quick and that could help an inside speed runner. STORMYLUX is by a 16% debut turf sire. Her dam went 4-0-0-0 on the green. Lone sib never tried the green.

Fifth Race 6-7-8

MEAN SHARON looks better if you discount that route try three back. Her recent tries are better and now she cuts back a half furlong to a distance that she likes at 16-3-3-5. Her versatile style is a plus but she will have to break in a new jockey today. HOT LAVA CAKE has speed and comes in fresh which might sharpen said speed a tad more. Other speed is still a worry. We know this mare likes this distance where she has won 3 of 5. Krigger rode our top pick last out but ends up here. THE COMRIE RULE ran OK three back when third at 43-1. She has been double digits in her last four starts here. So why does Harry Hernandez end up here? This mare does get good race flow.

9-12-11

Sixth Race BLACKSOD BAY has two sibs and both beat winners. He did beat half the field home in his second start. He returns to 6 1/2 furlongs and has some upside with this being only his fourth start. Cruz gets a leg up and is 30% for this barn. Class drop is noted. DORADUS has some solid figs and goes second time this level. He draws outside but has little tactical speed. Regular rider tags along but this barn is only 4% going route to sprint. AUDIBLE SILENCE goes second time here and drops in class. There just isn't much pace in this race and that hurts this closer. Keeping HH helps though.

5-4-6

Seventh Race SHARP ATTITUDE just won off the claim and did so as the favorite. Team Silva Jr is 34% with horses that won their last race. This mare tries this distance for the first time but she does like it here. Works continue sharp and win rider tags along. LUCKY BURGLAR has now won three of four so who is to say where her top is. She tried this tricky distance for the first time previously and ran a Beyer top. Other speed is the main worry even if this filly passed runners two back. This barn is 12% with horses that won their last race. ROCKBAR is a Triple A A A homebred so there is that. HH stays put as this filly adds a half furlong. A wide trip did not help matters two back. This race didn't come up very tough.

8-6-7-2

Eighth Race RAIL TOWN ends up in a barn that is 35% on the turf. The blinkers come off and that is a 1 for 1 move for team Rosales (paid \$14.98). This gelding puts three races together and finds a spot where he can't be claimed. Any chance this horse can rate? If so, chances improve. PACIFIC THEATER just beat half the field home and did so at 10-1. Second time with HH up can only help. This gelding is bred to like the green and both wins have come on the turf. OUR BLOKE tried the green for the first time last out and ran OK for a while before tiring. His turf Tomlinson of 340 is strong. Let's give this gelding another shot on the green then. GONZAGA is by a 8% debut turf sire. His dam went 3-0-1-2 on the sod and earned 5K. One of two sibs won on the grass at 10-2-4-0 (earned 36K).

Ninth Race KATAR is your defending champ. He has good speed and figures a great trip. We know he can fire fresh as he won this race last year while doing so. Win rider returns and we bet this horse can secure an early breather. The absolute one to beat. POP D'ORO is feeling great for team Diodoro. When this barn gets a horse good then often hold their form for multiple races. This gelding has tactical speed to help the trip but may have to chase our top pick in the early running. Horse for course is a bit unlucky to get stuck on the rail. BRANDYN did run a Beyer top two back. He draws the attack post and likes this distance at 2-0-1-1.

Race 1 - (2) PSALMSFORTYSIXFIVE drew well here after some tough posts in his last three tries, and I thought his third-place effort two weeks ago was pretty good. (3) FANATIC overcame a parked-out trip to finish third in his division of this event a week ago and moves in a couple of slots on the gate tonight. (7) SWISS HOUSE ONFIRE starts from the seven-hole but has been facing much tougher competition than he does this time.

Race 2 - (2) MOVIN' ON UP posted a second and a third in this class back in February, and tonight he drops, gets post relief and switches drivers to Matt Kakaley. (1) UNDRTHSOUTHRNSUN N took a couple of unsuccessful cracks at NW7500L5 company and slides back down to the bottom level tonight. He drew the pole and he hit the board against NW5000L5's on both 3-6 and 3-13. (5) ON ACCIDENT hasn't won this year but comes in from out-of-town in pretty good form and was Austin Siegelman's choice over UNDRTHSOUTHRNSUN N.

Race 3 - (3) HOBBS doesn't have a victory yet in 2025 but has raced well in amateur races when he's drawn well like he did tonight and he meets up with a field lacking a standout. (1) VELOCIRAPTOR is the lone horse in here who has been to the winner's circle this year and starts from the pole position. (2) PETER'S ROYALTY gets significant post relief this week and had a third in the winter series back in early February. He also hails from a stable that's been doing well as of late.

Race 4 - (1) KARLOO BRADLEY N won in this class two back and shows a victory against \$40,000 claimers on 2-12 as well. He moves in from post five to the pole position this week, and I'll swing with him. (3) SAULSBROOK HERO has been racing super since he joined Darran Cassar's stable and won a \$30,000 claimer in his return to Yonkers last Thursday. (6) TWIG was bothered early and didn't get involved from the eight-hole in his last try on March 17. However, he just missed by a head at this level prior to that and gets a driver switch to Jason Bartlett.

Race 5 - (4) BARN HALL rallied from way back to win in his debut for Jeff Cullipher last week. That stable is having a great meet thus far, he gets to move in a couple of slots on the gate and he was Scott Zeron's choice. (5) PASSIONATE PROMISE has four straight finishes in the exacta between here and The Meadows and makes her second start after rejoining Travis Alexander's barn. (7) BE DIFFERENT saw his win streak end on March 20 but did finish second, so he remained in good form, and I'll include underneath.

Race 6 - (6) I'M THE PRINCE beat open \$20,000 and \$25,000 claimers in convincing fashion in his last two appearances and I'll look for him to keep it going tonight as he faces age-restricted rivals. (2) FLIP MY CHIP tired on the front-end last time out but that was against open \$40,000 claiming company. He drops tonight and gets a driver switch to Bartlett. (1) COLD CREEK FELIPE never got involved from the eight-hole last Wednesday but was racing well prior to that and moves all the way inside to the pole position here.

Race 7 - (4) LEXUS KODY makes his first pari-mutuel start of 2025 tonight. He qualified back on 3-8 at the Meadowlands and won pretty comfortably, and I just think he's faster than the others in here as long as he minds his p's and q's. (6) CHULO has won three in-a-row for trainer Per Engblom and doesn't face the toughest group of NW2000L5's here outside my top choice. (1) FERRETTI owns a win and a second to CHULO in his last two

Race 8 - (7) THRASHER comes in with three straight victories and was re-claimed by trainer Edwin Quevedo. He does lose Bartlett tonight, but I'll go with his form and put him on top. (1) REAL PEACE hasn't won in a while but has hit the board in seven of his ten tries this year. He starts from the pole, gets reunited with Bartlett and hails from the Engblom barn. (6) CLEVELAND B MIKI never got involved from post seven last week but was racing very well before that and was Matt Kakaley's choice.

Race 9 - Invitational Trot (4) TIPSY MONI got stuck in traffic on the last turn a week ago but had plenty of trot once she got out. I think she'll return to her winning ways tonight. (6) SOUTHWIND COORS held sway on the front-end to take the Invitational last Thursday and had decent fortune in the draw for posts four through eight as he avoided the far outside. (7) BENJAMIN HANOVER prevailed in the Invitational back on 2-27 and rebounded from a poor effort on March 13 with a gaining third-place effort last week.

Race 10 - (3) MOHATU AS looked like he had trot in the stretch last week but got jammed up in traffic and made a break. He gets another chance to partner with Yannick Gingras here and I'll hope he has better racing luck. (1) AIRMANS JACKPOT has been in the exacta in five of her last seven outings and starts from the pole position, continuing a run of inside draws. (6) MAHONE SEELSTER shows two recent victories in this class, including a week ago. He does move out from post one to the six-hole but that might help boost his price a bit.

Race 11 - (6) ONE OF THE GUYS was a winner in his most recent start at Rosecroft and is now in a stable that often does well with first-timers. Add in that he gets to team up with Gingras, and I think he's worth a swing. (7) SOUTH POINT is on a lengthy run of sharp form and won in this class a couple of weeks ago. He was claimed again out of that contest and is now with Joe Bongiorno. (3) RICARDOSHILYSHALLY has a pair of recent runner-up results at this level and is now with Engblom off a claim, which also gets him Bartlett in the bike.
