First Race 6. Aerate 7. Ranger Battalion 1 Natural Hunk

AERATE returned to dirt last at Keeneland, and he had little chance to impact that race as it was holding together up front late; still thought he tried gamely from last, and moving up off the Rice claim might be a good sign. RANGER BATTALION has tried all three surfaces already, and improved to a slight new Beyer top when dropped for the first time at Gulfstream most recently; has faced tougher in both starts sprinting on dirt, including that race two back when shoeing speed; drops.

Second Race 7 Flat On 6. Macaw 1 Outsource

FLAT ON turned back to sprint at Keeneland two back and ran well in that spot while dueling a rival into defeat, before weakening in the stretch; that pace rival, Halmstead, was eased and has since won three of four starts, including a recent 91 Beyer effort; cuts back and drops after catching a sloppy track off the layoff. MACAW just missed in the first two starts of his career while favored both times; wound up getting vanned off the track when failing as the chalk for a third time at Saratoga last summer; finally broke through off the layoff last time when protected by Rice; threat if getting back to one of his fast races.

Third Race 6. Graywing 2. Bramito 4. Dots Dollar

GRAYWING rarely fails to show up, and he had won three of four with improving figs to kick off 2025, including a new top Beyer when up in class off the claim two back; dueled two different times before fading in that last one, but he is tactical enough to track a pace if necessary as he breaks from an outside post this time. BRAMITO rolled to a clear-cut win with a 92 Beyer when cut back to sprint two starts back; was claimed out of that race and got in too tough in his first start for the new connections last time; steps back.

Fourth Race 1. Have You Heard 6. Narciso Dali 2 Glint

HAVE YOU HEARD improved for Maker last year when winning his first two starts on dirt, both in one-turn routes; starts back from a layoff for this while also stepping back in class, which he seemingly needs at this point; like the one-turn mile for him, and his speed plays in this spot.

Fifth Race 5. Observer 8. Our Lil Surfergirl 6. Sounds of Summer

OBSERVER has caught wet tracks in both starts since stepping back in class, and he never had a chance with that 1/5 MSW dropper two back; was clearly second-best to another favored winner at this level in that last one; might be in the right spot this time. OUR LIL SURFERGIRL is a half to an eight-time dirt sprint winner, as well as three other winners on the track from this dam; drew well on the outside for De Paz, who is more than capable with a first-time starter. SOUNDS OF SUMMER rallied too late while along for third on debut; failed to build on that effort when catching a wet track last time; drops while adding Lasix.

Sixth Race 1. Twenty Four Mamba 4. Octane 2 Ridgewood Runner

TWENTY FOUR MAMBA was cleverly ridden when put on the lead in that last one, and he took full advantage en route to winning that race with a new top Beyer; also capable without the lead should this pace get faster, as is expected; logical right back off the claim. OCTANE earned a 99 Beyer winning the Big Drama sprinting three starts back, but that was nearly a year ago, and he has fairly bombed in his only two starts since then; has been given plenty of time since last seen, and his top race makes him tough in here if ready to fire in his first start for this trainer off the bench. NELSON AVENUE is inconsistent, but he also has a top effort that makes him tough in here; likely to get an aggressive ride as he cuts back to sprint.

Seventh Race 7. Son of a Birch 4. Hush of a Storm 5. Big Everest

SON OF A BIRCH has concentrated on sprinting throughout his career, though his lone attempt routing, which came early on, was not a poor performance while involved on a fast pace; he even ran better than it looks in the seven-furlong Paradise Creek as a 3yo when, once again, involved on a fast pace over a bog of a course; wish he was in better form, but he has talent and will be a price. HUSH OF A STORM rallied from last to finish a no-threat third in a yery strong race last time on synthetic (winner Mercante returned to just miss in a Grade1 on turf on Derby Day; 4th finisher Utah Beach won the Grade 2 Elkhorn in his next start); he went 2 for 3 on turf last year, with the lone loss coming in the Mohawk behind Spirit of St Louis, who has won two Grade 1 races since; he hasn't always been a plodder, though that seems to be the running style he has settled on lately, but there is enough pace in this race to set him up, regardless.

Eighth Race 1. Orie 9. Army Proud 6. Cousin Ed 3 Pandemic Hero

ORIE finished behind wire-to-wire winners in both turf sprint starts as a 2yo; dropping for his first start back, and he appears to be training forwardly up to this, and he might not have to improve that much vs this field. ARMY PROUD is similar to the top one on paper in that he sprinted twice on turf as a juvenile, faced tougher both times, and chased a dominant wire-to-wire winner when last seen; starts back for a tag with Lasix and blinkers on. COUSIN ED was up in class for his first start off the claim last time, and he was also cutting back three furlongs in distance for that race; owns the top turf figures in the body of the field, though he lacks the upside that the top two still have in hand.

"TROTTIN' THURSDAYS" RETURN, WITH FEATURES FOR VETERAN AND YOUNG HORSES ALIKE

After a one-week detour to Friday because of the Derby racing schedule change, we have "Trottin' Thursdays" back in their usual prominent place today. The \$15,000 ninth race featured fast-class handicap trotters have earned over \$3 million in their careers, and half of the field of eight has a win rate of over 30% in their racing lifetimes. There are two Philly track recordholders in ONCE IN A LIFETIME and BENJAMIN HANOVER. Two races later, horses working their way to higher spots on the ladder of success clash in a \$14,000 battle -- shipper CHIPPER DALE looking for his fourth straight success. ... Note recent racing trends in "WATCH OUT FOR," below.

ANALYSIS OF KEY RACES

<u>Strd race:</u> ALMOST PERSUADED has been showing steady improvement for Victor Kirby and Bryan Truitt, dropping time and moving up in company successfully. She has only six races lifetime, so she certainly still does have some room to improve. A couple of other horses get big figures, but we are persuaded ours seems the best value.

7th race: ALLINDOTIME had to try to overcome a two-move trip from post eight, and the exertion proved just a bit too much for the veteran. Today post five may be kinder to his chances, and Tetrick may find a winning trip. Young drivers Ryder and Miller are in good form, and they have the major rivals to our choice.

12th race: Many of the horses from the barn of the "American Viking," Trond Smedshammer, have hit the racetrack in 2025 in very good form, and WALSPEA, a pricey yearling, won her Q and may be ready right away. A value play could be BOURBON BUZZ, who has come to hand for Tom Shay and hot owner Howard Taylor.

14th race: SHIPSHAPE's form since winning the Pocono series has been far from shipshape; he might overpower these, but he also may be overbet. I FEAR NOTHING does cause us some fear with showing little recent early involvement, but first-time Estrada horses have been known to do well, so we'll take a shot on him.

WATCH OUT FOR:

This past week's race "evidence" at Harrah's Philly told a repetitive story throughout. Favorites came in in over half the races for the week, and when they didn't, close contenders did -- only two of the 41 races last week yielded a horse worse than third choice winning, and only five horses paid better than 9-2, with \$30.60 the top price of the week. Frontsteppers won about half the races, with first-overs (often clearing down the backstretch) second, and "pocket rockets" third. Be alert to these trends, and adjust -- but: you can't just "grab" for any horse to beat the chalk. And as always, watch the Exacta probables.

Race 1: Taking the short price and moving on with 8 RED THORN in the opener, as he lays over these while taking the biggest drop in racing, and could move forward in what is his dirt debut. Both 6 MIDNIGHT BOSS and 3 BLAZING TYREEK are next up, if the chalk should falter, though neither inspires or has the firepower of the pick.

SELECTIONS: 8-6-3-4

Race 2: Coming back to 7 GEEGEE'S STORY, as she had it going two and three-back then didn't fire last time, but the price will be right, and we know they can rebound from nowhere on Tapeta. No knocks if you think 6 ELLAGIO finally gets it done, as she ran well at the level last time and drew perfectly too. Getting back to Tapeta makes 4 CODA MIA a big threat, as that 2nd two-back would play with this modest group.

SELECTIONS: 7-6-4-9

Race 3: A drop in class, an outside attack post, and going second-off the layoff says look out with 6 TEOFIMO, as he ran well in his return in a fast race and meets no one to be scared of today. You'll take an underlaid price on 2 TOP MAVERICK, who has iffy form too, but he drops and finally gets some good spacing between races too, so you could see his best today. The rail isn't

ideal with **1 VIGANO**, but the dirt is, as his last two over it would likely win this.

SELECTIONS: 6-2-1-4

Race 4: Expecting better from 3 CAJUN SIS, as she blew the break on Tapeta in her debut then was in too tough on the main last time, so her experience and return to the surface makes her appealing. They all have to beat 6 MADE IN KUWAIT off that strong 2nd last time when she sprinted on Tapeta, though you're also allowed to look around at a very short price. Tapeta and Lasix could push 2 ADIOS TIPSY over the top, as her two Tampa races weren't bad.

SELECTIONS: 3-6-2-4

Race 5: It's Best Bet time, and a bold one at that, with 4 LA CYBER, as she returns to turf for the first time since her debut, and now stretches out too, while meeting a group there for the taking. Both 6 TRISH AND 3 WORTH CONSIDERING make sense, with the former luring Paco off a long layoff, and the latter running big (for this group) on turf, though both have drawbacks as well.

SELECTIONS: 4-6-3-2

Race 6: It's tough to go against the David barn right now, so 4 SLEW DIVA looks good, short price and all, as she comfortably beat older N2L foes and now faces just 3yos. You'll get a better price on **6 POP ROX**, who was just a length behind 'Diva, while backing up her strong win two-back too. Tread lightly with 2 GEAUX AMY, as she bombed when in way over her head, and will be way overbet on the plunge.

SELECTIONS: 4-6-2-1

Race 7: It sure looks like 7 CARNANE found a good group on her return to Tapeta, as this is a meek crew, and that MCL win two-back would be too tough for them. That 2nd when last routing on Tapeta from 2 EVANORA puts her in the mix, though she never wins, while 6 ABSOLUTELY WILD has faced better, but is another who is allergic to getting her picture taken.

SELECTIONS: 7-2-6-3

Race 8: It's Longshot time with 2 BIG BOY JAK, who should get loose over a course that plays to his speedy style, and with the rails at 73', he could get brave at a big number. Clearly 1 EMMETT is the one to deny on the stakes drop, while getting Lasix back as well, though note he's never run on the GP turf. That was a sharp MCL win by 5 CHILL THE J, who is now off-the-claim for Casse, and while he has upside, there are hurdles for an ice-cold barn.

SELECTIONS: 2-1-5-7

Race 9: The finale goes to 1 MARABINA on the MSW drop and addition of Lasix, as both are reasons a big breakthrough could be coming. Don't sleep on 3 LADY KHOZ, who has run well of late and now gets a potentially key jock switch/weight break as well. That voided claim last time, followed by a layoff, makes 2 QUEEN MCKINZIE a

dicey proposition, though she's the winner if she can get back to her last.

SELECTIONS: 1-3-2-8

Best Bet: R5: #4 La Cyber (4-1)

- * Back on turf for first time since debut
- * Should like getting back to two turns
- * Main (ML) rivals have some questions

Longshot: R8: #2 Big Boy Jak (15-1)

- * Looks like the controlling speed
- * Rails at 73' flatter his running style
- * Maragh one of the best on the lead

She likely gets that stalking trip once again. 1-NO NANNETTE NO should be right with Lucy's Lookin Left early. It's just a matter of if the pace comes back.

The outside draw may benefit her as she looks to find good early position.





SPOT PLAY-CALL ME THEFIREMAN (1st)

Race 1 - (4) CALL ME THEFIREMAN had no chance from back-to-back post eights at Saratoga but raced well the last time he drew inside on 4-7 and I'll give him a chance in what appears to be a wide-open event. (2) BIG CHARLIE MORAN also gets significant post relief and was second in the first leg of this series back on March 20. (7) CAMPBELLINI drew poorly here but hit the board in his last two tries over at the Meadowlands.

Race 2 - (4) TWIGGS PUB moves inside on the gate here after four straight outside posts and gets reunited with Jason Bartlett. His closing effort on 4-14 was good and I'll hope for an effort similar to that. (6) CAMOUFLAGE MONEY is on a three-race streak of second-place finishes and debuts for new connections off the claim tonight. (7) MUSIC HALL starts from the outside but won at this level last week and trainer Joe Bongiorno drives him again.

Race 3 - (4) SHOEMAKER HANOVER turned in another good effort from first-over last Thursday and is worth another shot tonight. He won in the opening round of this event back on March 20. (5) FANATIC lost all chance when he broke before the start a week ago but was the odds-on favorite in that tilt. He gets a driver switch this time. (1) PSALMSFORTYSIXFIVE was a winner two back at Monticello and overcame the eight-hole to post a fourth last week. He slides all the way inside to the pole position here.

Race 4 - (4) BUSY MAKING MONI did well in the John Brennan Trotting Series, including a second to the impressive Antognoni S in the final. He gets Yannick Gingras back in the bike tonight, and I'll give him top call. (3) BELLISSIMO FACE S broke while making a move to the front in the Brennan final but was sharp prior to that and has the potent Jason Bartlett/Per Engblom tandem in his corner. (2) BLACK MAGIC drops out of the Invitational and finished second the last time he was in this class on 4-10.

Race 5 - (1) DELIGHTFUL DUDE N returns from Plainridge off a fourth in a pretty quick mile over there. He starts from the pole and this stable has been heating up as of late. (2) ORLANDO BLUE A finds the bottom level here and was fourth against both NW10000L5's and NW7500L5's in his last two tries. (3) MARLBANK ROAD drops and gets significant post relief in this race. He shows a second in a NW10000L5 event as recently as March 11.

- Race 6 (2) BURNHAM BOY N posted a third-place finish in his first start back off the shelf a week ago and I'll swing with him tonight in the hopes that he's sharper with that mile under his belt. (4) SADDLE UP is on a strong run of form and comes off another win in this class last Thursday. He also gets reunited with Bartlett for new connections off a claim. (1) OZONE BLUE CHIP moves in on the gate from post six to the pole position and I wouldn't be surprised if that results in a more aggressive approach rather than the off-the-pace trip he got last week.
- Race 7 (4) HOT FLASH KIMMY doesn't have a victory yet this year but has hit the board in four straight outings and moves inside on the gate this time after she was third in this class last week. (5) BE DIFFERENT gained ground in a fourth-place result when he dropped back down to this level a week ago and gets a new driver this time in Mark Herschberger. (7) CANTSTOP YANKEE won a leg of the John Brennan Series and shows a third in the Invitational as recently as February 27.
- Race 8 (1) CLEVELAND B MIKI tallied in this class on April 3 and was a gaining third last week. He also slides in from post four to the pole position this time. (2) SAN DOMINO A has a pair of seconds and a victory since he was claimed by these connections and drew well again. He was also Bartlett's choice of four horses, including an Engblom trainee. (3) THRASHER has been victorious in five of his last seven outings, including in a \$25,000 claimer a week ago. He was re-claimed by trainer Andrew Adamczyk out of that race.
- Race 9 (1) UNEVERGONNAGETHIS double-drops out of the Invitational and was a gaining third two back in this class. He also gets reunited with Jordan Stratton and starts from post one again. (6) BRAVO ANGEL S is undefeated since she joined the Engblom stable for her 5-year-old campaign and her most recent victory came at this level. (7) INFINITY STONE starts from the outside but has a win and a second since he was claimed by these connections. He also gets reunited with Gingras, which probably means he'll fire out of there.
- Race 10 (1) BULLY BOY HILL turned a pocket trip into a win in his last try on 4-24. I think he's been sharp for a bit and will use him again tonight, especially since he starts from post one. (3) OVER AND BACK has posted three straight victories for the Bartlett/Engblom duo and drew another good post here. (8) BARN HALL starts from the outside but has tallied four times in five appearances since he came to Yonkers. He debuts for new connections off a claim and gets Gingras in the bike again.
- Race 11 (2) WALKINSHAW N prevailed the last time he faced NW7500L5's at Yonkers back on March 24 and comes out of a fast race up at Plainridge most recently. (5) SPORTY M THREE drops again and scored in a similar class to this one at the Meadowlands on 3-1. (4) BLANK STARE suffered interference and had to settle for sixth a week ago. He takes another shot at this level tonight and gets a driver switch to Bartlett.
