Race 1 - BIONDETTISNITEMARE looks poised for success after a neck defeat to Naksu in a similar race last month, demonstrating her ability to compete at this level. My Daniela, who finished third in the same race, could pose a threat if building on that performance. Queen Kitty, stepping up from a mile, warrants consideration following a close second place finish in a less competitive event, though she may find this company more challenging. 4-8-3

Race 2 - EMERALD EYES stands out in this claiming contest, having shown promise with a close fourth at Belterra Park last time out. Despite a slow start, she finished strongly, suggesting potential for improvement over this C&D. Credit Check, while disappointing in a more competitive race here recently, has winning form at the distance and could bounce back. Razzberry Ripple warrants respect after a solid third place finish over course and distance, demonstrating her ability to handle the track. 7-6-1

Race 3 - THE SWEATY FOX, a prolific winner over shorter distances, steps up in trip but brings impressive form, having triumphed last time out at this course. Sadie The Goat, also a course winner last month, demonstrated her prowess with a commanding victory and could pose a significant threat. Miranda's Rocky, no stranger to success here, finished runner-up to Sadie The Goat in their recent encounter and cannot be discounted in what promises to be a competitive affair. 5-1-3

Race 4 - BAH HUMBUG commands respect after an impressive eight-length victory at this track, demonstrating her affinity for the course. Yellow Feathers, despite a fourth-place finish last time out, showed promise in a more competitive race and could challenge here. Overly Dramatic's recent runner-up performance at Mountaineer Park suggests she's in good form and shouldn't be overlooked. This trio appears to have the strongest claims in what promises to be an intriguing contest. 5-3-1

Race 5 - RUNAWAY POWER looks primed for success after a strong second-place finish over C&D last month, beaten only 5 1/21 by Fast And Friendly. His consistent form and familiarity with the track make him a solid choice. Mor Stormy, third in the same race, has shown promise with three placings in eight starts and could challenge if building on that performance. Ohio First, despite finishing fifth on debut, is worth considering given his pedigree and potential for improvement in this maiden special weight contest. 6-7-1

Race 6 - THANKS FRANK stands out as the top contender, having previously triumphed over Libertango at this course and distance. Despite a disappointing run last time out, his prior form suggests he's capable of bouncing back strongly. Libertango, narrowly beaten by Thanks Frank in their last encounter, looks primed for another strong showing and could pose a significant threat. Gamboling Ghost, though coming off a subpar performance, has demonstrated ability at shorter distances and might find this race more suitable. 6-1-5

Race 7 - BRIGHTER DAY looks poised for success after an impressive victory at this course last month. His recent form and familiarity with the track make him a strong contender. Relish The Ride, now with a new stable, showed promise in his last outing here and could challenge for top honours. Authentic Cowtown, despite a disappointing run at Mahoning Valley, has a solid record at this distance and might surprise if returning to his best form. 5-6-2

Race 8 - SAMMY AND SHORTY stands out despite a disappointing run last time, having previously shown class in higher-grade races. Weekend Buzz enters with confidence after a gutsy win here and could pose a significant threat. Pecks Not Bad, though absent since last July, has a solid record at this distance and merits consideration. The trio's proven ability to handle the track gives them an edge in what promises to be a competitive claiming event. 6-7-2

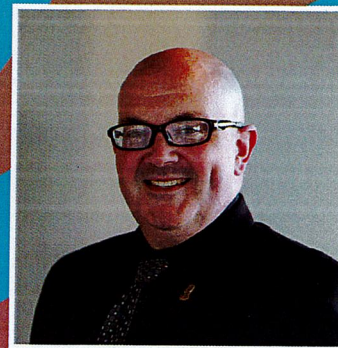
