Race 1 #7 NOHUCHI has been kept in jail since the August 27th purchase, and is promptly dropped in class by 60% after his third consecutive fourth place finish. Even with a win and another claim, the connections send to lose approximately \$15,000. Take a looooong look pre race. #2 NANTZ hung up an adjusted 62.6 the only time he went from 2X to 1X, and he also hung up a couple of nice figures in his last pair on a fast surface. #8 LAST MAN STANDING (uncoupled barnmate with our top choice) is another one plummeting off the purchase, but must be left in the mix because of his Beyer figs.

Race 2 #2 BRZINA went to coast to coast like butter and toast when last in action back in mid May and we like to see that she's protected against another purchase today, as she has been snagged in her last three outings. She's done well off of layoffs, and the 6 for 7 record at today's tricky distance positively leaps off the page. #1 WHISTLER'S STYLE slides in seven slots and drops a pound for today's first start off the 9/14 purchase, and has completed the exacta in all four starts at this trip. Plodding plodder will need some pace in front of her, as well as some space late in the game. #8 PROBLEMATICA has tons of early dash, and owns the sort of declining mark that we've grown to love over the years.

Race 3 # 5 FULLY SUBSCRIBED returned off an elongated absence to pick up 12% of the pot up at Saratoga on Closing Day, and now has the miracle drug added for the first time. Logical contendress. #3 SCARLETT'S HALO (uncoupled barnmate with the above) was a visually impressive winner in his sole dirt deal, and factor that along with coming into today off of career best turf effort, and you'd have to think he's live. #4 COQUITO has done nice work at the trip and over the strip, and popular item at the claim box has had to leave a forwarding address in her last three starts when up for grabs.

Race 4 #5 GRUMBLYRUMHOGAN gets his working papers today, and does such with a few quick moves on the worktab, including a sixth best from a whopping 211 runners on the 6th of this month, and accomplished such from the gate. January foal has a maturity edge over the entire field, and needn't be much despite the unproven turf pedigree. #7 OGILVY has some solid bloodlines for this sort of deal, and should be left in the mix. 5-7-1

Race 5 #2 COMPETITIVE THREAT has ascended the Beyer scale over each of his eight afternoon treks to the front side, so right off the bat, who knows where his ceiling is in that regards. The bad news though, is this one's penchant for burning some cash, and while we will be using, it is with a touch of trepidation. #1 ARTISTIC SUCCESS is another one whom you can draw an upwards arrow alongside the BSF's, and this miss has displayed appreciably better speed since beginning her routing game. #3 SASSY PRINCESS could come along for a share.

Race 6 #3 BRAVARO gets his working papers this afternoon, and does such with a decent 374 Tomlinson figure, as well as a best of 49 gate bullet up at Saratoga. Of the three upstairs members of the family tree we were able to unearth, one scored first time out, one got the job done i the follow-up, and one was victorious in his third outing. Note that the jockey/trainer combination are four of six in tandem with two year olds, and the winners came back a juicy $$12 \times 2$, \$7, and \$91. #1 COMBAT MISSION outran his parimutual offering quite nicely when showing at 21-1 in the debut, and at the very least, he now has experience when breaking from the inside. #10 THE TOY CANNON (named after baseball player Jimmy Wynn) has been working well for today's lidlifter, and owns some decent breeding.

Race 7 #2 CONNECT THE STARS has ascended the Beyer scale since starting things out back in June, and after the three straight placings on this turf, is promptly switched over to the main, which suits us just fine, as she is precipitously better bred for the stuff. Slight edge in a wide open event. #3 ALL ABOUT YOU has outran her odds quite nicely with the two in the money finishes to start out her career, and switches over to Castellano today, who is two for three when riding for McPeek at 10-1 or under (\$20 and \$10). #4 CONCURRENTLY was a bit tardy to the party first time out, but has fired off a bullet since, and cuts back while switching over to the brown stuff.

Race 8 #2 MAGIC PATHWAY comes in off back to back career best figaros, and although she is facing the stiffest test of her career, we like that she displayed improvement when running without the miracle drug for the first time. Timid choice in a race with no first draft tosses. #4 GRIFFIN'S WHARF showed a nice "Z" pattern when going on the gramma for the first time, losing more than two lengths from the quarter to the half before gaining more than half a dozen from that point to the finish line. That race has yielded three next out winners from seven returnees, with an average speed figure improvement of 4.7 points per. Watch out. #3 X Y PRIME showed a decent adjusted number when trying the blades for the first time back in July, and is as good as any for the show dough.

Race 9 #3 DOMINICAN PIRATE has gotten a positive trainer switch since last seen back in July, and although at first glance the overall ledger doesn't look too inspiring, we like to dig deep to try to find something positive in maiden races, as they are maidens for a reason. That being said, the trip debut last October yielded and adj. 69.9 speed #, and it came against tougher, while without use of the wonder drug. Bombs away! #4 DEEMER has gotten better and better over time, and slides in seven post positions for today's third start of the bench. Logical, once again. #2 LET'S FIGHT bested more than half the field when going over the verde for the first time at the end of August, and picks up Flavah Flav of that troubles sojourn.

ANALYSIS OF KEY RACES

6th race: To us, the major dangers in here are HEISMAN PLAYER and SIX FEET APART, and we will give a small edge to the latter because of his inside positioning on the starting gate. The PLAYER looks to be bouncing back to form, and if "SIX" tries to go wire-to-wire, as he did in this class on August 3, the PLAYER may get the good trip behind him.

11th race: WATER SPORTS TEEN has shown tremendous early speed at times — such as in his last race, when he went unreal fractions then battled on to miss less than a length. And AGAINST BETTER! We're not sure anybody else here has the power of WATER SPORTS TEEN if he brings his "A" game today.

12th race: FALKIRK has done well racing in Pennsylvania, including a win at this level at Pocono. We suspect that the long stretch at Lexington's Red Mile was not in harmony with his strengths — we think he may do better away from the mile oval. His return may mark a visit to the winners circle to Team Pelling.

15th race: ALWAYS HAS BEEN is another shipper who may find the Keystone State more friendly to him than the Bluegrass State. He's been racing well in their Goldenrod Series (the third level in Kentucky), showing enough speed to get good trips. Though still a maiden, we think he has a good chance in the finale.

WATCH OUT FOR:

Real devotees of developing trends on a given card will want to pay very close attention to the first three races at Harrah's Philly

today. All three are claiming races, and all feature competitive horses, many of whom have lots of early speed, and most of these horses are scheduled to be piloted by drivers who favor an aggressive style away from the gate. It looks like some of the battles for the front end early on the card will be fierce, and if closers are not to have the "bias" totally against them, we think come-from-behind horses may do a little bit better than normal at these races. Watch and see if this trend is notable!

MAV MAN missed by a half-length in his third start; one more forward move can land him an off-the-pace win. He is trained by Leonard Powell, who also entered front-runner/pace-presser ~ZAGREUS^. The latter ran okay in his comeback last month on dirt. He pressed a strong pace, hung tough to deep stretch, and tired to fifth. Not bad for his first start in more than two months, over unfamiliar footing. ZAGREUS returns to turf, and could win with a forwardly placed trip. ~CRIME LORD^ looms the upsetter, stretching out from a sprint in which he pressed the pace and finished fourth. He is quick enough to make the lead in this two-turn race. FIGHT BACK is an 11-start maiden who will roll from behind.

On the plus side, his rivals are modest. ~GATHERED^ ran okay in his comeback, missing by less than four lengths in a maiden turf mile. He has never raced on dirt, but he worked fast on dirt at San Luis Rey Downs and might have more speed than the top choice. GATHERED also drew better in post 4. First-time starter ~DEEP BLUE^ is by Echo Town, whose older progeny (3yos and up) have won 4 of 12 first out.

Two turns is a long way for the distance-challenged sprinter, but she does figure to be loose. OLE SILVER might be ranked too low. Her summer races at DMR were not good, but she is 4-for-7 on SA dirt.

A two-turn race was out of reach for ~YELLOW SUN DRESS^ last out; she missed by two lengths at this N1X level. She benefits by a cutback to six furlongs and return to SA turf. DRESS sprinted four times over the course: three wins and a second. Her versatile style allows her to press the pace or rally from behind. Stakes-placed ~THE WILD GRAZER^ needed her recent comeback; it was her first start in nearly a year and a half. She was no match for tougher rivals in that N3X/classified allowance, but drops to N1X while entered for the optional \$50k claim tag. Second start back, she should move up vs. easier company. ~DARE TO FLY^ has earned decent numbers on dirt, this is her first try on turf. She is by Daredevil, whose progeny have won an above-average 16 percent in turf sprints.

~APPROVAL RATING^ was in tough and off the board both summer starts at DMR. She prefers the SA dirt track on which she scored a win and two seconds early this season. 'RATING drops to N2L \$25k claiming, and is the tepid choice in a race that looks wide open. ~LENA LINDGARD^ meets winners after an ordinary win in a \$12.5k maiden-claiming sprint at DMR. She improved 10 points over her debut, and if she makes a similar forward move third out, she fits with these. ~SEI BELLA^ drops from the same starter allowance as the top choice. The runaway maiden win by 'BELLA two starts back would be fast enough. MAXIMUM GOLD might be listed too low. She finished fourth last out, in front of both APPROVAL RATING and SEI BELLA. 'GOLD is a logical contender and must-use in multi-race wagers.

The trainer of 'SMILEY, Brian Koriner, won with 4 of his last 9 second-start maidens in turf sprints. ~BOOKED CLUBHOUSE^ produced a strong rally in his debut, runner-up by a length racing five furlongs on turf. He should appreciate the longer distance of this six-furlong sprint. First-time starter ~DARK BLUE^ is a sibling to King's Plate winner Mansetti and minor stakes winner Straight Up G. It is uncertain if 'BLUE is cranked for a top try first out, but progeny of Maxfield have done well first out: 9 for 35 (25 percent).

~CAVALIERI^ and ~RICHI^, Bob Baffert-trained stablemates, face three others in the G2 Zenyatta Stakes. CAVALIERI, undefeated after four starts, is making her first start since she won the G1 Beholder Mile in March. She has worked well for her return and figures to come back firing in this prep for the BC Distaff. RICHI lost to her stablemate in the Beholder, but the tables could turn owing to the current-condition advantage of RICHI. She crushed a G2 in April, and followed last month at DMR with a decent third in the highly rated G1 Clement L. Hirsch. RICHI is the "now" horse. CAVALIERI may be undefeated, but it is a close call between her and RICHI, who is using this route race to prep for the BC Filly and Mare Sprint. ~SUGAR FISH^ was only prepping when she ran around the track and finished fifth in her comeback. It was the first start since December for 'FISH, who won this stakes last year. She should improve second start back over a track on which she has won 4 of 7.

Despite the bad trip, she earned a career-high speed figure. ~PRINCESA DEL TIGRE^ is speed, third start back from a midseason respite. QUANTUM INNERGY has no speed whatsoever, but she will be rolling in the lane.

He has done well since, he has speed to press the pace, and he loves to win: 10 for 21. ~DR. VENKMAN^ parlayed a rail-skimming trip to victory last out in a seven-furlong G2. This six-furlong race might be too short, but he will be finishing. SPEED BOAT BEACH once was a top sprinter, but that was way back in 2023. He ran poorly both starts as the favorite since. Win or lose, 'BEACH can keep the pace honest.
