Best Bets: DELICATE (5th) - COBBLE ROAD (9th)

Race 1 5 CRAIGH NA DUN – Overmatched in last and brutal trip this level in prior outing; makes 17th try.

- WEEK'S STRONG Distant fourth in tougher version this spot and fired two previous starts.

 REDOUBTABLERIPKEN Retreated with wide trip in latest and claimed by sizzling Pino barn.
- KERNER Faded behind longshot winner after dueling; making key third race since layoff.

Race 2

- POGI Difficult to like or ignore drop after competing well in Jersey-bred stake; handles these.
- 2 JUSTINSPEIGHTOFIT Battled streaking winner at Monmouth and local success in past.
- WE READY Closed well in narrow loss this spot and used up dueling in prior attempt.
- SIR MI TOLEE Cost more than twice this amount two starts back; voided claim before layoff.

Race 3

- 2 SIMPLY DISREGARDED Gained after early roughing on turf and crushed maidens locally.
- MAX FORWARD SPEED Keeps firing and returns to level of July claim; figures close.
- 4 CARNABY Better than odds suggest at loftier level and trio prior tries encouraging.
- PROBATIONER Disappointed in compact field but five-time winner eligible as 3-year-old.

Race 4

- CANTARO Significant drop after competing in tough field; third outing since hiatus.
- PRACTICAL COACH Decisive score this level when claimed; 12-time winner keeps Sanchez.
- JEBOLOGIST Sharp in "key" race at Monmouth after Pino claim and six local victories.
- GO EAST Good effort behind second pick and also from Pino stable; upset Delaware rivals.

Race 5

- DELICATE Hard used setting pace in classier company and Mosco stable has them firing.
- RINGER CARD Raced sparingly but game effort this spot when losing via disqualification.
- LEILAUNI SUE Edged with similar when making first start in two months; obvious contender.
- BUTTER KISSES Trounced maidens in local bow and flattered when runner-up won next out.

Race 6

- TARIBA DREAM Overmatched in last and prior defeat on turf; realistic drop with closing kick.
- 2 YOU KNOW ME Yet another taking steep drop and upset winner last month; stretching out.
- RAGTAP GIRL Set pace and continued well this level sprinting; romped in Monmouth route.
- 4 MIKEY'S SONG Competed only once since May but capable in past and removing blinkers.

Race 7 GET SET – Veteran stretch-runner closed with rush and pair of scores in June; ample targets. FINAL SHOT – Ten-year-old dueled and battled to finish this spot; long career in Preciado barn. MAGICNTHEMOONLIGHT – Formidable on best but sidelined since March; comes out flying. GUAPONESS – Anticipated more last time but nearly overcame troubled trip this spot before. Race 8 AMEDEUS MUSIC – Strong closing kick then idle since July after Ness re-claim; prevails if ready ALWAYS GAMBLING – Upset slightly easier after Wyner claimed and takes logical next step. RIVALRY – Lasted against lesser and claimed by Lake; draws inside again and faces pressure. PRINCE COLTON – Set pace and continued gamely this spot on muddy footing; likely duel. Race 9 COBBLE ROAD – Led to final stages in tougher field and crushed rivals in prior outing. 4 CRYPT – Advanced nicely after hiatus for new connections; sufficient early targets. FORWARD MOVE – Responded well taking plunge at Laurel; possibility for leading stable. MYSTIC LUTE – Speedy and determined in recent months; edged two-time winners recently.
