1st Going to give a slight edge to #5 EVIE'S PRINCE, based on the fact that he had a solid lead in the stretch before losing the rider the only time he went from a flat event to the jumps, along with having been a part of the superfecta in 15 of his last 17 starts when the jockey has stayed aboard. #3 ZARAK THE BRAVE enters today off a well clear runnerup finish in the Jonathan Sheppard, and will likely take some pounding at the windows. #8 WELSHMAN got a confidence building win when last seen at the end of August, and the fact that he was ridden out despite scoring by open lengths tells us that Fisher had this race in mind all the time.

Race 2 2 TOXIC GIRL has never run a race as fast as the likely favorites in here, but she is getting back to what she seemingly does best, routing on dirt; has recently experimented with turf and turning back to sprint distances; actually some signs of improved form last time when staying on at 6F after losing some early position; now gets back to the right distance, and should be a fair price for lower profile connections. 8 YO LEVEN will be a handful if she can get back into form here; was pretty disappointing when last seen here in June, but she just never looked comfortable over a sloppy track that day; now drops to a realistic level and gets a massive rider upgrade to Flavien Prat.1 SPIRIT OF ESTHER has run well on both dirt and turf in the past, making her last couple of performances pretty concerning; wasn't really persevered with on turf race last time; still has to prove that she remains capable of competitive efforts.

Third Race Turning back to a sprint distance should suit 8 PATIENCE N GRACE,** Best Bet ** who showed some promise on debut when passing over half the field with a rail rally; wasn't quite as effective last time, but winner Material Girl is better than anything she's facing here, and she also seemed to struggle getting a mile after a wide trip; has had some time off since then, but returns with blinkers after training well in that equipment this summer at the Spa. 5 SUNSHINE LILY had a legitimate excuse when last seen finishing up the track at Saratoga, as she stumbled very badly at the start; had run well over this course and distance prior to that, and looks pretty logical . 8-5-7

Race 4 #4 INNATE has been extremely sharp in both starts this year, after returning off an 11 1/2 month hibernation, as he is but a nose shy of having a two for two record in 2025. Barn switches to a jockey they have done good things with over the last couple of years, and gelding could be sitting on another good effort in today's third start off the pine. #3 FELTRINELLI hasn't been seen in a couple of Bijou's birthdays, but returns with Lasix added and as a first time gelding. Note that his only start off an absence yielded a gutsy victory right here. #8 BOSUN shoots for the hat trick today, with improved speed figures over his last three tries.

Race 5 #9 FRAUDSTER improved by leaps and bounds when going over the green nearly three fortnights back, and as this one went for eight times the stud fee at Ocala a half'a year back, one would have to think he's been well meant along. #2 PAMPERED came along belatedly to complete the super when getting her working papers up in the Adirondacks, and slides in six slots off of that effort. #10 ISADORA DUNCAN has fantastic pedigree for the weeds, and could be any kind.

- **Race 6** #4 O P FIRECRACKER is halved in price after being claimed for a double sawbuck two back, and found the line first in and identical placement just before the pair of recent disappointments. Sensible selection. #2 BOLD ENDEAVOR had no palpable excuse for the flopola last out, but was a reclaim from the prior trainer that day, and the two of them teamed up for a 5:2-2-0 mark together. Check earning sort will not be able to ply his trade on this circuit in a few months, because of a silly rule in place banning ten year olds. #7 LAUGHING BOY finds himself at his lowest level to date in this, is 41st start, and 7YO makes all kind of sense.
- Race 7 #5 LINARITE was made available for purchase for the first time in nearly two years last out, and ended up in a different barn after another check collecting effort. After being kept in jail, new shot caller puts a right up for sale once again, and this mare owns a 7:1-3-2-1 record with claiming company. Mild choice in a race with just one first draft elimination. #1 STRICTLY TABOO comes in today off a lifetime best figaro, and as that came at this level, who's to say a repeat isn't doable once again. #2 KERRY outperformed her expectations solidly enough when placing directly behind the above in their recent encounter, and we see no reason to dismiss.
- Race 8 #5 BEFORE THE WIND has the best overall body of work in the field, as this fella has partaken in the super in his last three, and accomplished such despite not being favored in any of those events. Despite having blinkers added last out, he encountered a decent amount of trouble with about a quarter of a mile left in a race, and deserves a chance to make amends today. #6 OAT COUTOUR is another steady sort who was a lively runnerup finisher the only time he went long on the lawn, and we like this one's ability to send or rate a bit. #1 INSPEIGHTOFCHARLIE isn't particularly well bred for this surface, but slides in four post positions while having blinkers on for the first time.




