- WINNIE MAE Rallied nicely behind second pick in debut when ignored at 100-1 in wagering.

- 9 MELITTLEFROSTGIRL Excellent speed in longer test when edged by huge favorite in best yet.
- SHUDABEENACOWGIRL Battled throughout in compact field after Gallimore claim; rail speed.
- HALA BLUE Responded favorably to plunge firing on turf and dirt; closer than odds predict.
- 2 CHAMPAGNE MISCHIEF Yet another front-runner exiting maiden score in Jersey; fits nicely.

- CHARM OF THE SONG Sufficient ability but idle three months and serious contender if ready.

Race 8 -5 PONDER AND DREAM – Dueled and continued gamely in debut; winner heavily-backed shipper. MISTER ME – Outran top choice in bow and moves inside as obvious threat for top stable. CONNOR'S CREW – Out of dam which captured terrific 18 races primarily on Maryland circuit. OUR NOTION - By leading Maryland stallion Great Notion and worked half mile "bullet" from gate Race 9 GLOWS IN THE DARK – Rallied behind formidable rival in sprint; should like additional yardage. UP N RUNNIN – Easily second best in sprint stake and showed route prowess in maiden romp. IRISH BANBA - Edged tough field of maidens in just second race of year; can continue progress RACEY RUBY – Numerous strong efforts but difficult to support off last; sheds seven pounds. Race 10 HARP'S HOT CORNER – Difficult to like or dismiss plunge; great record with Sanchez aboard.

AHSAD – Returns to amount of August claim seeking 16th victory in amazing 105th attempt.

CATIRE VIZCAYA – Chased speedy winner in mud and possible pacesetter stretching out again.

MAJOR THOMAS – Wired on Penn turf when high percentage barn took; handles various footing

Race 1

#3 On My Time

#4 La Culasse

#2 Scotch Mist

#3 ON MY TIME rallied to fourth in the Catch a Glimpse but was stuck with the 11 hole, raced wide and came up empty when routing over this course on September 13. She draws a much better post this time and could rebound at a decent price. #4 LA CULASSE is a very deserving favourite here after leading into deep stretch and finishing third by 3/4 lengths in the Grade 1 Natalma. A repeat of that effort will make her very tough facing maidens. #2 SCOTCH MIST debuted in the same race that On My Time exits, falling back to last after being bothered at the start and rallying to be third. She should be very live with a clean trip. #5 MEILANI was in front in the stretch but was second best, 1 1/4 lengths ahead of Scotch Mist on September 13 and looks logical.

Race 2 #7 Bucyk #6 Glasweigian #4 Sunday's Well #2 Joe West

#7 BUCYK chased the pacesetter but was a clear second best when dropping in for this tag on September 21 in his first start since July. He should have a good stalking trip here. #6 GLASWEIGIAN came up empty in the stretch when facing OS/\$40,000 company on September 28. He has run more good races than bad this year and should appreciate the drop in class. #4 SUNDAY'S WELL chased the pacesetter and emptied out when finishing a half-length behind Glasweigian on September 28. Speedy gelding will have to deal with Tiger Town early; we'll see if he can get anywhere close to his impressive July 20 maiden score. #2 JOE WEST arrives from Finger Lakes where he has been facing allowance company with decent results. He is a wild card in his Tapeta debut; he should appreciate cutting back after a route try last time.

#1 TIME ZAPPER added blinkers and ran a game second by just a half-length on September 14. He has a significant experience edge and should be best here. #4 MASTER STEAL is by 11-for-55 juvenile debut sire Signature Red, and is a full brother to the multiple Stakes-placed sprinter Cara Cara. He has been working steadily. #5 MR. PERFECT set the pace but was outkicked by Navy Street when making his second start on September 21. We'll see if he is good enough to hold off Time Zapper. #3 PROUDLY CANADIAN is by 12% juvenile debut sire Souper Speedy, out of a mare who has not had a winner in two foals to start. He had some quicker breezes in the summer but has been working slowly coming into his debut.

#2 THIS DUDE A BREEZE got caught in a tough speed duel and came to a stop when last racing on September 26. He catches a field with less speed and could rebound with a softer trip. #7 SHERIF ALI took a couple of starts to come into his own but has raced very well in his two most recent starts for these connections, rallying strongly to win the aforementioned September 26 race. As long as he doesn't bounce he will be tough again. #3 SWAN LAKE stalked the pace and hit the front in the stretch but could not hold off Sherif Ali last time. He was able to win at this level back in June and has been knocking on the door for another one. #1 TIZ ROMANTIC takes a sharp drop in for \$15,000 after an empty effort against N1X/\$32,000 on September 13.

#2 WAGNER came up empty when trying two turns on the inner turf on September 26. He drops in for \$25,000 and gets back to the synthetic which he raced well on as a two-year-old; with pace to close into he could be live at a price. #1 SECRET THREAT has been knocking on the door in his two most recent starts at this level, improving a bit since adding blinkers. He is another who will benefit from having pace to run at. #4 PAINTTHETOWNSILVER was closer to the pace than normal and emptied out when dropping in for \$40,000 on September 7. He drops again and could rebound with a return to his normal lateclosing style. #5 BACKONTHECHAINGANG dueled on the lead and ran a game second at this level on September 26. He has been in great form all season but runs the risk of getting caught in a battle with He Shoots He Wins.

#2 CAJUN INFLUENCE is by 16% debut sire Bucchero, and is a half to multiple Stakes-winner Cajun Delta as well as a couple of other Stakes-placed runners. He had a fast gate workout on September 21. #3 TIME PASSES was a distant third when making his Woodbine debut on the turf back in August. He has had time between all of his starts and tries the Tapeta now; the breezes have been well spaced. #1 MO' SPRESSO ran on to a decent fifth-place effort when switching to the Tapeta on August 24. He is probably best on the turf but doesn't seem to be in an out-of-reach field here. #5 MUNNYSTRUCK showed some interest when debuting on the turf at Fair Grounds in February. We'll see how he fires in his first start since March.

#7 GRAFFITI WRITER had a tough post when plunging in for this tag on October 3 and ran a decent fourth in a sprint. He re-adds blinkers while getting back to a route which is likely more ideal for him. #3 CONACHER plunges in for bottoms after a fringe fourth-place effort for \$25,000 on September 28. He was claimed for \$15,000 and the barn is making several aggressive drops lately so I would not see this as a real red flag. #6 ARMINO wheels back in nine days after rallying up the inside to break his maiden for \$10,000 and looks like a contender in this attempt to double up. #2 KING PUTT is another last out-winner, finding more on the front end to win over nine furlongs on September 18. He probably won't get the lead as easily in this spot. #5 GLOBETROTTING made a nice rally to break his maiden for \$10,000 on September 7 but was outclassed against \$25,000 foes three weeks later. He could definitely rebound getting back to a realistic level.

PRESQUE ISLE (Post 3:30) By Dick Powell

Race 1

1st: (5) VALIANT VICTORIA – dropped down to this level two starts back in her second start of the year and held on for third after disputing the pace. She was a good second last out when moved up in class for the Spieths.

2nd: (2) RUNAWAY BREEZE – one-dimensional closer just missed by a nose two starts back, then was an even fourth last out for Katy Cheeks, who wins 12% with her sprinters. 3rd: (4) ECHO SEVEN – tired in her PID debut, then held on for third after taking the lead in the deep stretch.

Race 2

1st: (4) STARSHIP LEGACY – could not keep up two starts back in a very fast race, then came back and rallied for second when stuck behind a dawdling pace. John Fennessy's last 204 maiden claiming starters show a flat-bet profit.

2nd: (6) PIVOT TO THE POWER – British-bred mare tries synthetic for the first time. She had no shot against males on the dirt two starts back, then was a close second from post 10 on the turf.

3rd: (1) DOWHATEVERITTAKES – still a maiden after 13 tries, but she rallied for second in her PID debut last out.

Race 3

1st: (3) MALIBU MUSE – missed by a length in her career debut on the dirt at Indiana, then tired next out going seven furlongs at Colonial. She showed good speed before tiring when blinkers were added last out at Churchill. (1) MACLEAN'S LULLABY – ran second three times on the Tapeta at Turfway, but was outrun in her last two starts on the turf. She makes her PID debut for Pavel Matejka, who wins 22% with this surface switch. (4) FORBIDDEN FRIEND – daughter of McKinzie makes her Tapeta debut for Vicky Oliver.

Race 4 1st: (5) THALBERG – horse for the course just missed here two starts back, then won by three lengths in fast time last out. Justin Morrell wins 11% with his claimers, and he gets leading rider Antonio Gallardo back aboard. (2) KOTYLOS – rallied for third two starts back against better, then moved way up in class and was a good fourth. Randy Russell wins 29% with this dropdown and 17% with his synthetic-track starters. (7) PEARL OF ACLAIM – began the season with a good win here, then won two turf sprints at Penn.

Race 5

1st: (9) HONOR BRIGHT – rushed up to press the pace in her well-bet career debut on the dirt at Delaware Park, and now the daughter of Quality Road makes her Tapeta debut for Mike Stidham. (5) MIDWEST PRINCESS – was an even third going two turns in her well-bet career debut for Will Walden, who wins 33% with his second-time starters and 30% when he adds blinkers. (1) COLONIAL SENSE – first-time starter is working well for Riley Mott.

Race 6

1st: (4) EXPRESSO BAY – romped by over seven lengths in his well-bet career debut on a sloppy track at Penn, then came here and just missed for Todd Beattie, who wins 27% with his overall two-year-olds. (5) LEFTNATEAWALKIN – broke his maiden last time out when he dominated on the front end from post 8 and now faces winners from a better draw. Scooter Davis wins 35% with his allowance runners. (6) JES SEE ME – broke his maiden by seven lengths against state-breds, then ran well against open company.

Race 7

1st: (2) TODDCHERO – went gate to wire two starts back when he dropped down to similar company, then he just missed when moved up in class in a long sprint. Juan Arriagada wins 36% when he rides Gallardo. (7) YOU BET A FORTUNE – speedball won his first three career starts at PID, then he was a good third in fast time as the heavy favorite. He could not make the lead last out, but the outside draw could help him here. (4) SAINT GOAR – just missed against similar company two starts back, then missed by a nose last out.

Race 8

1st: (5) FADETHENOISE – chased the pace in his PID debut two starts back, then dropped down to this claiming level and won easily as the 2-5 favorite. Brandon Kulp wins 29% with his claimers and 25% first start after a win. 2nd: (6) SHY DA RUNNER – tired late going two turns here when dropped to this level, then came back at six furlongs and won easily at 3-5. Martina Rojas rides for Kulp – 2-for-9 together. 3rd: (8) RANSOM MONEY – drops down to bottom claimers for the first time and gets Gallardo.

Race 1 6 - 2 - 4

#6 Balladeer – This horse has never run down the hill and he hasn't run in a sprint in about 3 years. But...He hasn't been in a race this easy in about 3 years either. Just look at that line. It has been a steady diet of Graded Stakes races for as far as the eye can see. This may not be his ideal distance, but his class and the great outside post should be enough to get him the win. #2 Bad Uncle Barry –This guy on the other hand is undefeated down the hill. He will be and should be the favorite. They will all have to beat him to win. #4 Tejon Pass – He has the distinction of having beat Bad Uncle Barry. He is a legit threat.

Race 2 5-2-7 Best Bet of the Day!

#5 Mr.A.P. – His TG numbers tower over these. You know how I feel about Vlado as a trainer. He is outstanding. With a clean trip and against these, he is the most likely winner of the race and my best bet of the day! #2 Cherokee Nation –His lone race was decent and earned a good TG number. He is trained by the GOAT so he must be respected on the stretchout. 7 Eruption – His lone race was at this mile distance and that is a tough distance to debut in. Added to that the race came up super tough as a few of them came back to win. It was a very key race. Don't dismiss.

Race 3 1 – 6 – 4 #1 Unbridled Scholar – It is impossible to ignore this mare's last race. It was scintillating! She won by 8 and that TG number was sensational. A repeat would put her square in the winner's circle. #6 La Scaloneta – Her TG numbers are actually better than the top choice. But they were earned on the grass. If she can transfer those numbers to the dirt then she surely will be a factor. #4 Catalina Cocktail –She takes a big drop in class. She does have some decent TG numbers, and this drop could be her wakeup call.

Race 4 3 - 2 - 5

#3 Voucher – I really can't figure this race out. The ones with experience just do not do it for me. This first time starter has a couple of really fast works. Quinonez is not the best with firsters but this one might get him a win in that area. #2 Tascadero – The same can be said for this guy. Good works; a trainer that doesn't win with firsters often. #5 Rostron – I guess he looks best of the ones that have run.

#3 Origami – I thought this filly was ready to take a big step forward last time out and unfortunately clipped heels and lost the rider. Here is her chance to make amends and I think she will do just that. #4 Skatingthroughlife – Looked great breaking the maiden at this surface and distance. Last race was a bit too long for her. Now she returns to a sprint and should be right there at the wire. #5 Unbinding – She has a good late kick and can get a piece.

Race 6 1 - 8 - 10

#1 Not Happy – She has earned the best TG numbers in the race, and they were earned against much tougher company. DeLeon tips his hand as he names the ultra-talented Berrios to ride. #8 Flamingo Star – Woke up with her best race last time out and that was in a 9th place finish. She should be a good price and should have a big say in the outcome of this race. #10 Darlin Sugaree – She has only one race so she is not a proven loser. That race was encouraging and she can improve second time out.

Race $7 \ 3 - 11 - 4$

#3 Word Play – This edition of the Swingtime is incredibly competitive. MANY can win in here. This one is riding a three race win streak and is super hot right now. I love her speed, and they will all have to go by this one late to win. It won't be easy.But I think she can handle the raise in class. #11 Vibez – She just ran the best race of her life and that was following two close second place finishes. That last race win stamps her as one of the main contenders in here. #4 Nadette – She has to be seen as the class of the race as she has competed in a long string of Graded Stakes races. She is a deep closer so you may not hear her name easlry in the race but you will surely hear it late.

Race 8 4 - 3 - 2

#4 Bazooka Charlie – Superb effort last time out. He ran second that day almost breaking his maiden. None of these have run that fast. He has gotten better with each and every race and I fully expect him to graduate today. We will see him in the winner's circle after the race. #3 Maxville – He has the second best overall numbers. This looks like an ice-cold exact to me. #2 Mom Says – He popped and then stopped abruptly last time out. He might forget to stop today.

#3 Lady Chic – She looked completely uncomfortable last race. She was rank throughout and never seemed to have her head in the game. I am willing to completely forgive that poor effort. Her previous effort was outstanding. A repeat of that race would demolish these. Can she get back to that race? I believe she can.#6 Helga Brandt – She has the SPECTRE if being a major threat to her competition. She earned a very good TG number last time out. You only live twice so give this one a shot. #7 Heads in Beds – Three starts resulted in three third place finishes. She can get the show dough again today.
